**Parish Membership:** We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not active parishioner.**

#### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony:**

The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

#### **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:**

Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

#### **Pastoral Care of the Sick:**

Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

**Magnifica Humanitas**

La Encíclica del Papa León XIV sobre la custodia de la persona humana en el tiempo de la inteligencia artificial

La dignidad del ser humano como criterio para orientar el progreso tecnológico.

*El Papa León XIV, al presentar al mundo y a todo el pueblo de Dios su primera Carta Encíclica sobre la custodia de la persona humana en tiempo de la inteligencia artificial, declaró: "Invito a todos los miembros de la Iglesia y de la familia humana: aprendamos a escucharnos unos a otros, afrontemos con valentía los desafíos presentes y cooperemos en la construcción de una sociedad más humana y fraterna. [...] Por favor, lleven con ustedes el compromiso de permanecer despiertos y ser 'artesanos de esperanza' para seguir construyendo la obra de nuestro tiempo. Que el Espíritu del Señor Resucitado sostenga nuestro trabajo común".*

**La Encíclica, en síntesis:**

... Para escapar de tal peligro, es necesario, por consiguiente, **CUSTODIAR LO HUMANO EN LA TRANSFORMACIÓN (cap. #4)**. El primer ámbito que requiere atención es el de la verdad: en una era en la que todo es susceptible de manipulación, es preciso custodiar una educación crítica que nos permita distinguir lo verdadero de lo falso. El segundo ámbito es el del trabajo: cuando la eficiencia se convierte en el criterio dominante, el trabajo corre el riesgo de perder su valor humano y relacional. El tercer ámbito es el de la libertad: amenazada por las adicciones digitales y la recopilación masiva de datos; su defensa exige una regulación justa, responsabilidad compartida y educación. Para custodiar las condiciones de una vida auténticamente humana, capaz de verdad, trabajo digno y libertad real, es necesario un esfuerzo conjunto.
