Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not active parishioner.**

#### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony:**

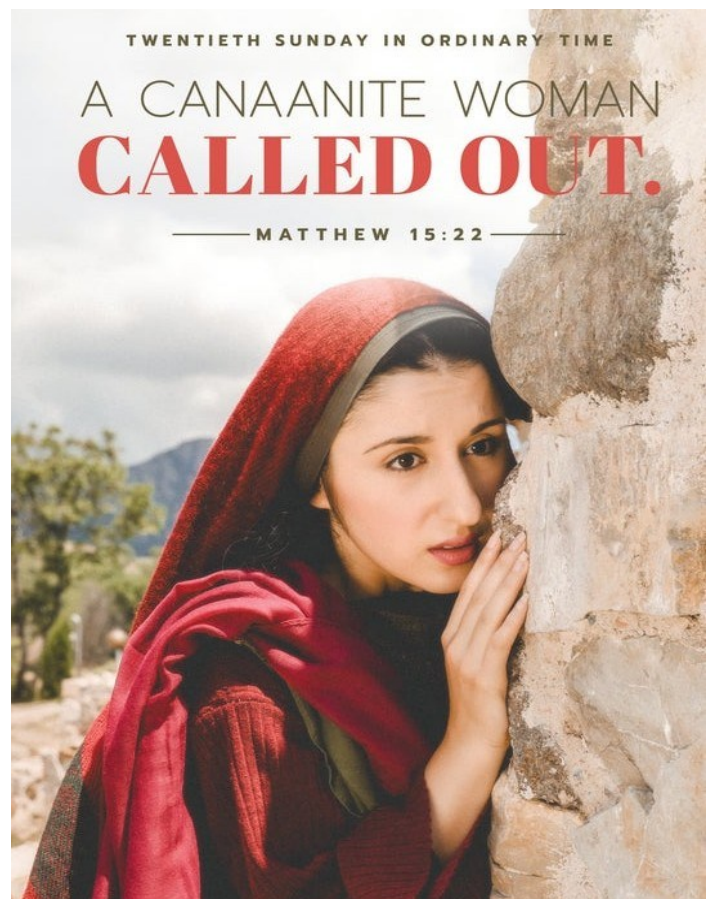

### EXHORTACIÓN APOSTÓLICA DILEXI TE DEL SANTO PADRE LEÓN XIV SOBRE EL AMOR HACIA LOS POBRES

Un Iglesia para los Pobres

*La Iglesia y la educación de los pobres*

69. En el siglo XVI, san José de Calasanz, impresionado por la falta de instrucción y formación de los jóvenes pobres de la ciudad de Roma, en unas salas anejas a la iglesia de Santa Dorotea en el Trastevere, creó la primera escuela pública popular gratuita de Europa. Era la semente de la que después se desarrollaría, no sin dificultades, la Orden de Clérigos Regulares Pobres de la Madre de Dios de las Escuelas Pías, llamados escolapios, con el fin de transmitir a los jóvenes «la ciencia profana, al igual que la sabiduría del Evangelio, enseñándoles a descubrir en sus acontecimientos personales y en la historia la acción amorosa de Dios creador y redentor». De hecho, podemos considerar a este valiente sacerdote como «el verdadero fundador de la escuela católica moderna, que busca la formación integral del hombre y está abierta a todos». Animado por la misma sensibilidad, en el siglo XVII san Juan Bautista de La Salle, dándose cuenta de la injusticia causada por la exclusión de los hijos de obreros y campesinos del sistema educativo de Francia en aquel tiempo, fundó los Hermanos de las Escuelas Cristianas, con el ideal de ofrecerles educación gratuita, una sólida formación y un ambiente fraternal. La Salle veía el aula como un lugar para el desarrollo humano, pero también para la conversión. Sus escuelas combinaban la oración, el método, la disciplina y el compartir. Cada niño era considerado un don único de Dios y el acto de enseñar un servicio al Reino de Dios.

**Apostolic Exhortation DILEXI TE of the  
Holy Father Pope Leo XIV  
to all Christians on love for the poor  
CHURCH FOR THE POOR**

**The Church and the education of the poor**

69. In the sixteenth century, Saint Joseph Calasanz, struck by the lack of education and training among the poor young people of Rome, established Europe's first free public school in some rooms adjacent to the church of Santa Dorotea in Trastevere. This was the seed from which the Poor Clerics Regular of the Mother of God of the Pious Schools, known as the Piarists, would later emerge and develop, though not without difficulty. Their goal was that of transmitting to young people "not only secular knowledge but also the wisdom of the Gospel, teaching them to recognize, in their personal lives and in history, the loving action of God the Creator and Redeemer." In fact, we can consider this courageous priest as the "true founder of the modern Catholic school, aimed at the integral formation of people and open to all." Inspired by the same sensitivity, Saint John Baptist de La Salle, realizing the injustice caused by the exclusion of the children of workers and ordinary people from the educational system of France at that time, founded the Brothers of the Christian Schools in the seventeenth century, with the ideal of offering them free education, solid formation, and a fraternal environment. De La Salle saw the classroom as a place for human development, but also for conversion. In his colleges, prayer, method, discipline and sharing were combined. Each child was considered a unique gift from God, and the act of teaching was a service to the Kingdom of God.

Order of Christian Initiation (OCIA). The Order of the Christian Initiation, OCIA, is the ordinary way in which adults who were not raised in the Catholic Faith become initiated into the Catholic Church through Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation. Who is the OCIA for? It is for adults from all walks of life who consider joining the Catholic Church: someone who was baptized Catholic, but never received any other Sacraments:

- Someone who was baptized into a different faith.
- Someone who was never baptized and is beginning their faith journey.

**PRELATURE  
OF ESQUEL**

Pope Benedict XVI created the Prelature of Esquel (Patagonia – Argentina) on March 14, 2009 from the Rivadavia Diocese.

This Prelature covers more than 30,000 square miles and a population of about Fr. Jose Slaby a member of the Congregation of the Redemptorist Missionaries became the first prelate- bishop. Presently four diocesan priests and ten order priests (two Salesians and eight Redemptorists) serve in the new Prelature. Three female religious congregations (presently 17 nuns) provide pastoral services.

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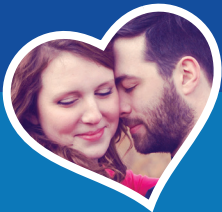
