

Congratulations to the 60 students from our parish who recently celebrated Confirmation at St. Joseph's Cathedral in Hartford. This year Archbishop Blair required that all Confirmations be held at the Cathedral and not in the local parishes. Due to pandemic challenges and age of the retired archbishops/bishops traveling to each parish could no longer be supported. Each parish was asked to choose a date where up to 200 candidates from different parishes would attend. It is an opportunity for all to experience the larger diocesan church and the reverent experience of being in the spectacular Cathedral of St. Joseph.

The pandemic has had a significant impact on the way confirmations have been prepared for and celebrated these past two years. Confirmation is a two year Faith Formation commitment. In 2021 programs and service opportunities were offered online only. In 2020 & 2021 small groups of socially distanced, masked candidates celebrated the Sacrament locally. This was quite an accomplishment for the students, their parents, guardians and the parish. It was, and continues to be, an unprecedented time and all should be affirmed in their commitment and accomplishment. It would not have been possible without the deep desire of faith in God that has been cultivated for the past 10 years. Thank you parents, grandparents and sponsors! Father Bob, Fran Walsh and I were genuinely impressed and enjoyed our conversational individual "interviews" with each student who shared their experiences, questions and desire for Confirmation. It is quite powerful when you see the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit working in the lives of young people. May these gifts grow and be strengthened as each continue their journey with Jesus.

The support of our parish community, strong teaching and pastoring during the many years of Faith Formation needs to be acknowledged. Fran Walsh is an exceptionally gifted and committed teaching minister and coordinator with our 9th and 10th grade students. Her energetic, faithful, fun and powerful lived example of faith resonates purpose and joy in every session. For 15 years she has embraced the program, parish, and every student with faith, hope, love and laughter.

Many teachers and leaders have accompanied these students to this point and have a significant hand in and blessed their faith experiences: Annette Williams, Jackie Beauvais and all GIFT teaching ministers, catechists and volunteers-we offer deep gratitude for the ways you have shared your faith. Deep appreciation to the Faith Formation Team Jay Szymansky, Renee Bogdanffy, Andrea Woronick, Jen Lynch and Kim Sherwill for all your hard work that is an essential piece to every part of the program. And to our pastors whose leadership, perseverance, dedication and love have blessed each one in significant ways known and unknown to us- we are grateful! 


