only for today

WELCOME SUMMER!

What are your plans for these days and months?

Vacations, staycations, home projects, hosting visitors, time with family, resting, reading, extra work hours and maybe doing nothing in particular... Is your faith a part of your summer plans? Here is a suggestion that might work for you (and your family see link for the children's book) that fits in to any place or plans you may have. Saint John XXIII created a top-ten questions list known as a Daily Decalogue titled **Only for Today**. As Pope John XXIII this was his personal *daily way*, and were resolutions he tried to live each day. The list touches on the most essential things we do each day and suggests a way to make the average moments of our days into something holy. If all 10 are too much for your day-try reflecting on one or two that speaks to you the most. Pope John is most known for convening the Second Vatican Council, which set in motion major reforms of the church, its structure, liturgy and relations with other Christians and other religions. His papacy may have been short, 1958 to 1963, but it was profound.

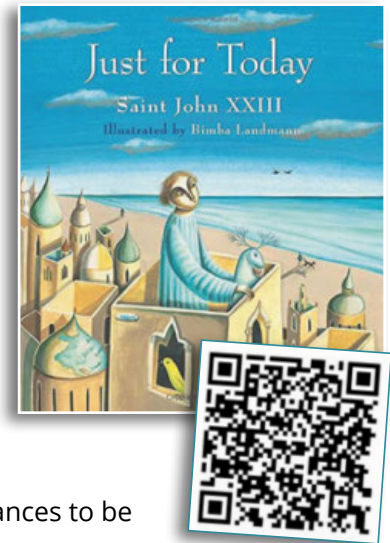
Take a moment to slowly read through each one:

1. **Only for today**, I will seek to live the livelong day positively without wishing to solve the problems of my life all at once.
2. **Only for today**, I will take the greatest care of my appearance: I will dress modestly; I will not raise my voice; I will be courteous in my behavior; I will not criticize anyone; I will not claim to improve or to discipline anyone except myself.
3. **Only for today**, I will be happy in the certainty that I was created to be happy, not only in the other world but also in this one.
4. **Only for today**, I will adapt to circumstances, without requiring all circumstances to be adapted to my own wishes.
5. **Only for today**, I will devote 10 minutes of my time to some good reading, remembering that just as food is necessary to the life of the body, so good reading is necessary to the life of the soul.
6. **Only for today**, I will do one good deed and not tell anyone about it.
7. **Only for today**, I will do at least one thing I do not like doing; and if my feelings are hurt, I will make sure that no one notices.
8. **Only for today**, I will make a plan for myself: I may not follow it to the letter, but I will make it. And I will be on guard against two evils: hastiness and indecision.
9. **Only for today**, I will firmly believe, despite appearances, that the good Providence of God cares for me as no one else who exists in this world.
10. **Only for today**, I will have no fears. In particular, I will not be afraid to enjoy what is beautiful and to believe in goodness. Indeed, for 12 hours I can certainly do what might cause me consternation were I to believe I had to do it all my life.

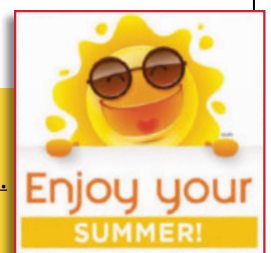
Which of these resolutions speaks to you most directly? How can you put it into practice today and how can you encourage someone in your life to do the same?

The learning theme for this coming catechetical year is prayer. Please join us as we seek, knock, ask and grow in faith together! Central to prayer is knowing that God desires a deep and intimate relationship with each one of us. Just as each individual is unique, our relationships with God and ways of communicating with God are unique. "Lord, teach us to pray." (Luke 11:1)... In six sessions we will explore various ways of praying which can foster that relationship and grow in love of God and neighbor. We are happy to announce the return of the half-hour meal segment of the program that had been eliminated last year due to the pandemic. G.I.F.T. is for everyone ages 6-106! It is not only a catechetical program for children and families-it is for adults of every age and stage of life. There are all-ages together openings and closings, age appropriate student learning sessions and engaging adult-specific segments led by pastoral staff and guest presenters. G.I.F.T. builds community, deepens faith and involves worship and parish life. The program consists of six 2.5 hour sessions which meet once in September, October, November, January, February and March. Please see the schedule and session choices on the next page. Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation require participation in G.I.F.T. as well as additional sacramental specific workshops detailed on our website. 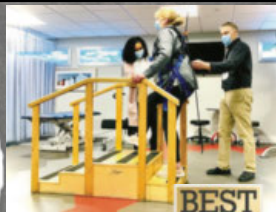

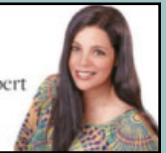

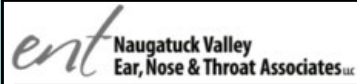
