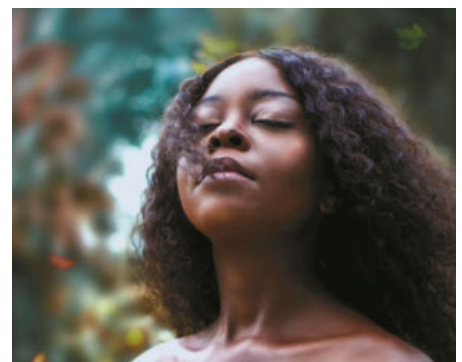

Central to prayer is knowing that God desires a deep and intimate relationship with each one of us. Just as each individual is unique, our relationships with God and ways of communicating with God are unique. "Lord, teach us to pray." (Luke 11:1)...

In six sessions we will explore various ways of praying which can foster that relationship and grow in love of God and neighbor. We are happy to announce the return of the half-hour meal segment of the program that had been eliminated last year due to the pandemic. G.I.F.T. is for everyone ages 6-106! It is not only a catechetical program for children and families-it is for adults of every age and stage of life. There are all-ages together openings and closings, age appropriate student learning sessions and engaging adult-specific segments led by pastoral staff and guest presenters. G.I.F.T. builds community, deepens faith and involves worship and parish life. The program consists of six 2.5 hour sessions which meet once in September, October, November, January, February and March. Please see the schedule and session choices on the website. 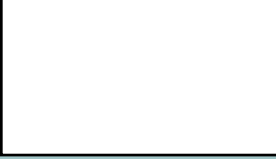
