THIS IS US

Its 5:15 PM on Taco Tuesday as Mission Trippers stand in line in the cafeteria at Ridgeview Community School in Dexter, Maine. If the tone of openness, energy and accomplishment, that fills the air, is a sign what is to come in the days ahead, I can certainly proclaim the trip was a success!

If you are not familiar with what happens on a Mission Trip here is a quick synopsis. Teen age/young adult Christian Youth Groups and adult leaders from across the country gather in a community who have residents in need. Most are elderly with homes that need interior/exterior repairs or improved access with wheel-chair ramps, steps, or decking. "Work Crews" are created from the various groups with 1 adult and 5 young adults/teens. Home for the week is a local school where Jesus centered programs are held featuring music, video, faith reflections and are led by Group Workcamp staff. Devotions and prayers are part of the work crew and youth group components. There is free-time for social gathering and quiet time.

I asked some of our members questions about why they attended and their thoughts and experiences to date. Here are their comments:

"I heard it was fun because my father and sister attended."

"It is not an easy experience. There are ups and downs during the week. But the take away from this is the relationships. Getting to know the residents and their story. When I get home I think about the impact I made and was made on me."

"Inspiring hope."

"For the past 5 Trips I have said the same thing- it is the BEST week of the summer."

"Acts of service and love. It helps me continue and connect with my faith."

"I came because of my friends. Sharing this (experience) with them has been great."

"Meet new people."

"Help people in need."



"I wanted to try something new. I think I'm from a wealthy town and this woke me up to see how some don't have what I do."

"I am learning new things and putting myself out there in to a new experience."

"Give back to my community. I like to use what I have for the good of others."

"People said it was a good experience."

"My parents made me. They said this is part of what we do as a family of faith. As my brother and sister went they wanted me to have the same experience and opportunity. I see now how important it was that they did this."

"Really nice. Everyone is really nice."

"Social aspect. Have time to talk to people."

"I see the impact on the neighbors in the community. There is joy in the faces of people you are not directly serving."

"The residents we serve are amazing. I didn't think about that through the experience they would have an impact on me."

"Learning basic trade skills and knowledge of how to do things. I would never do that at home."

"I need to have a good balance of faith in my life. This shows I can do that."

In the coming week look for more thoughts and God Sightings from the Mission Trip participants and their experience in Dexter, Maine.

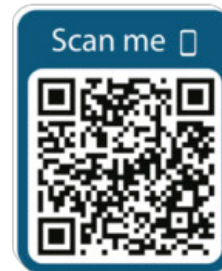

The learning theme for this coming catechetical year is prayer. Please join us as we seek, knock, ask and grow in faith together! Central to prayer is knowing that God desires a deep and intimate relationship with each one of us. Just as each individual is unique, our relationships with God and ways of communicating with God are unique. "Lord, teach us to pray." (Luke 11:1)...

In six sessions we will explore various ways of praying which can foster that relationship and grow in love of God and neighbor. We are happy to announce the return of the half-hour meal segment of the program that had been eliminated last year due to the pandemic. G.I.F.T. is for everyone ages 6-106! It is not only a catechetical program for children and families-it is for adults of every age and stage of life. There are all-ages together openings and closings, age appropriate student learning sessions and engaging adult-specific segments led by pastoral staff and guest presenters. G.I.F.T. builds community, deepens faith and involves worship and parish life. The program consists of six 2.5 hour sessions which meet once in September, October, November, January, February and March. Please see the schedule and session choices on the website. Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation require participation in G.I.F.T. as well as additional sacramental specific workshops detailed on our website. 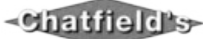
