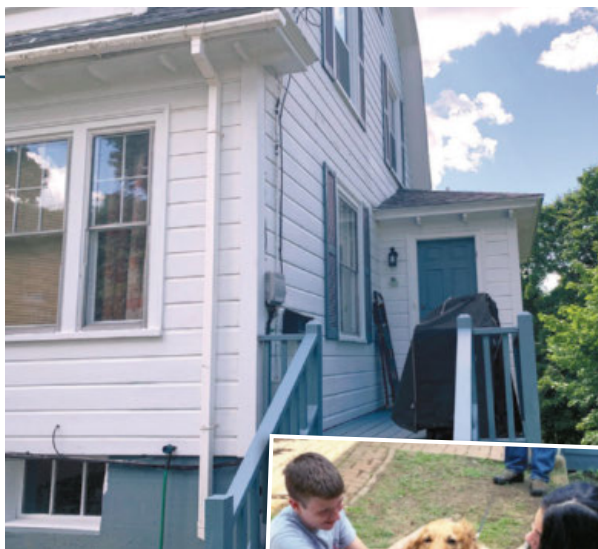

Mission Trip God Sighting -continued from cover

But I am NOT at all big on skills and am also quite afraid of heights. On paper, our project was simple: scrape, prime and paint exterior doors, windows and paint exterior steps and stain a deck. I was relieved as it seemed to be in my skill set. My first God Sighting is to be assigned to a manageable project within my very basic skill set. Monday morning, we pulled up at our work site and met our resident: a Maine Native in his 70s, with some health issues and a beautiful lovable Golden Retriever.

The house was once beautiful: over 100 years old, classic white with blue trim. We saw a 3 story home in a state of disrepair: peeling paint, rotten wood, over grown with multiple hornet nests. We quickly began our work, the 5 of us wanted to do a good job for our resident. On Tuesday the challenges were getting real: 3 extension ladders were delivered to our site so that we could access the second story windows and trim. It was nerve wracking to move the heavy 25 foot ladder from point A to point B and seemed nearly impossible to get it stable enough to climb. Progress was very slow and we were becoming a bit discouraged. At our crew devotions we talked about purpose. On Wednesday, we met Tim: and WOW things started to turn around. Tim lives in Dexter and knows our resident personally. He was active in the process of bringing our work camp to Dexter and organizing which community members needed our help. Tim used to manage properties and estates he also used to care for apple orchards: He had much experience and a LOT about ladders. He had stopped by our site just to check in but then he never really left: He became an invaluable addition to our work crew. He taught each of us how to efficiently move those big heavy ladders and then how to safely set them up even on uneven terrain. He taught us how to caulk the weather damaged windows and how scrape, but not overly scrape this old house. Tim worked right along with us for the rest of the week. He joined our lunch group, shared our devotional time and brought us Klondike bars. He talked to us about Dexter and more about our resident. He gave us inspiration AND know how! Even I became confident painting when up on a ladder (well less uncomfortable). My crew of 5 agreed, Tim's support was a God sighting for the rest of the week. We accomplished our projects and our resident was so appreciative that his home looked good again. We were grateful to be able to help!

This was my second time going on Mission Trip. Now, everyone in my family has had the opportunity to go and we all really love it. It is a week when we really let God into our lives. We worship with music every morning and evening. We participate in group devotionals at lunch on our job site and in the evening to let us reflect on how God helped us through the day. It becomes easy to spot "God Sightings." It is an honor to be a chaperone for our parish and be a part of this faith forming experience and these kids bring hope. We see their joy of serving others and real friendships grow. This is why so many of us agree that Mission Trip is 'best week of the summer.'

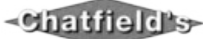
