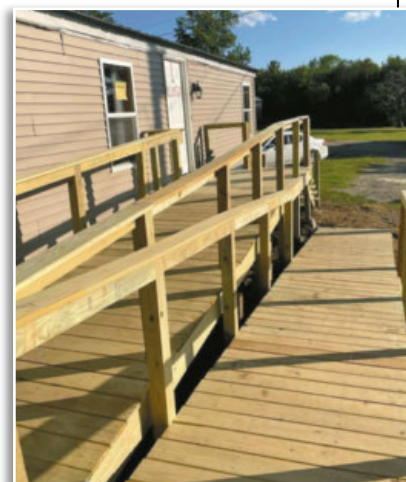
Mission Trip God Sighting

First my group was made up of 15 young people with three adults including myself. We were given a job that entailed ripping down an existing porch and replacing it with a 16 foot ramp to a turn around and then a 24 foot ramp for our resident Ernie, who is wheelchair bound. The entire week we were working at Ernie's house, his wife Mary and their granddaughter Katie stayed outside with us talking and making connections with us. Katie was also a great baker and she made goodies for us everyday. At lunch and devotions, Katie and Mary also joined in thanking God for the help as we thanked God for the opportunity to help. To listen to a young person thank God for the chance to help someone in need is a most amazing revelation. God is present in every good deed we do it is up to us to notice his presence.

We not only made connections with Ernie, Mary, and Katie, they had an 11 year old neighbor, Sam, who was outside waiting as we pulled up everyday. Sam became one of the crew and helped with all the work. Our young people treated Sam like a little brother and when they weren't working they were playing basketball with him. Sam also joined in lunch and devotions and he shared what he is most thankful for. Sam said "you guys have been the best part of my summer and I am thankful you came to help Ernie, and thank you for letting me help. By the end of the week, our group, who first met each other on Sunday night, became a family that extended our love to Ernie, Mary, Katie, and Sam.

As the week went on, an area contractor named Dave came by to help anyway he could. He shared a story that Ernie was the one person in his life when he first moved here that treated him like a person and he would do anything for Ernie and his family. Again, I can't say I had a specific God sighting, but I was reminded of God's real presence all week long and I can't wait to go next year.



At this time, we want to take the opportunity to thank Jen Enger, our Church Accountant, for her expertise and sharing her awesome gifts for our Church and Finance Council for the last 12 ½ years here, at Sacred Heart and Mid-South Catholic, as she leaves this part-time position to take on a full-time position.
