

Do you know what Boxing day is?



What is Boxing Day and why is it called Boxing Day?

Boxing Day is celebrated on the **day** after Christmas, December 26th each year in various countries around the world, generally those that were settled by the British Commonwealth. It is believed

that **Boxing Day** originated because the servants of wealthy families typically had to work on Christmas **Day**.

A 'Christmas **Box**' in Britain is a **name** for a Christmas present. **Boxing Day** was traditionally a **day** off for servants and the **day** when they received a 'Christmas **Box**' from the master. The servants would also go home on **Boxing Day** to give 'Christmas **Boxes**' to their families. The **name** is a reference to charity drives.



Feast of the Holy Family, <u>Roman Catholic</u> religious festival falling on the first Sunday after <u>Christmas</u>. Although major <u>feast</u> days dedicated to each member of the Holy Family—<u>Jesus</u>, <u>Mary</u>, and <u>Joseph</u>—also exist, the Feast of the <u>Holy Family commemorates</u> their life together, and the celebration focuses on religious family life.

Because of the flight of the Holy Family into Egypt, a feast for the Holy Family has been observed by the Copts from early times. In Western Christianity, however, a cult of veneration for the Holy Family as a group, rather than as individuals, did not arise until the 17th century and was not officially recognized until the feast day was formally instituted in 1921 under

Pope <u>Benedict XV</u>. Originally celebrated on the Sunday after <u>Epiphany</u> (January 6), the Feast of the Holy Family was moved to the Sunday after Christmas in 1969, bringing it within the Christmas season.
