### *Do you know what Boxing day is?*



What is Boxing Day and why is it called Boxing Day?

**Boxing Day** is celebrated on the **day** after Christmas, December 26th each year in various countries around the world, generally those that were settled by the British Commonwealth. It is believed that **Boxing Day** originated because the servants of wealthy families typically had to work on Christmas **Day**.

A ‘Christmas **Box**’ in Britain is a **name** for a Christmas present. **Boxing Day** was traditionally a **day** off for servants and the **day** when they received a ‘Christmas **Box**’ from the master. The servants would also go home on **Boxing Day** to give ‘Christmas **Boxes**’ to their families. The **name** is a reference to charity drives.

Feast of the Holy Family, Roman Catholic religious festival falling on the first Sunday after Christmas. Although major feast days dedicated to each member of the Holy Family—Jesus, Mary, and Joseph—also exist, the Feast of the Holy Family commemorates their life together, and the celebration focuses on religious family life.

Because of the flight of the Holy Family into Egypt, a feast for the Holy Family has been observed by the Copts from early times. In Western Christianity, however, a cult of veneration for the Holy Family as a group, rather than as individuals, did not arise until the 17th century and was not officially recognized until the feast day was formally instituted in 1921 under

Pope Benedict XV. Originally celebrated on the Sunday after Epiphany (January 6), the Feast of the Holy Family was moved to the Sunday after Christmas in 1969, bringing it within the Christmas season.
