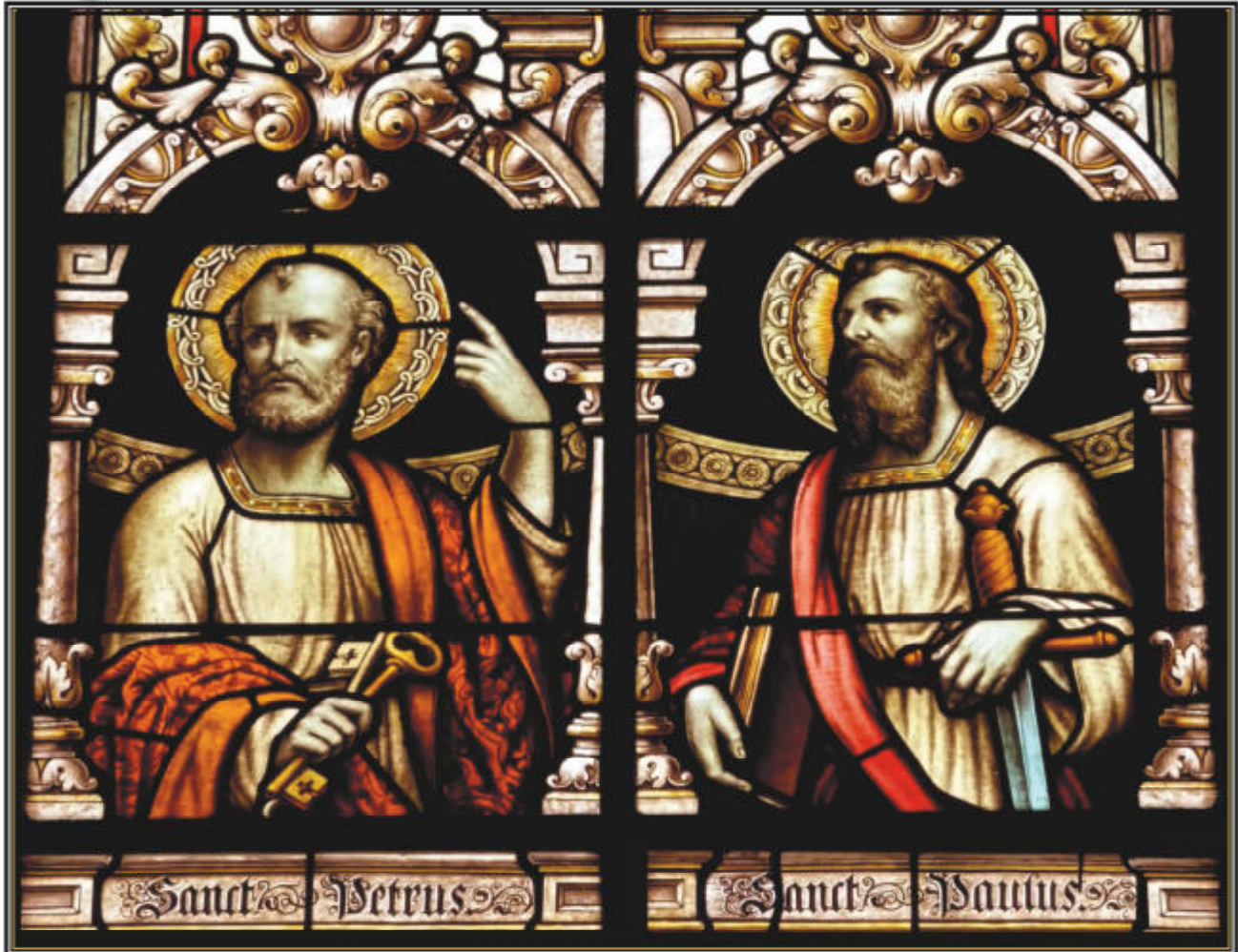

FROM THE RECTOR

My dear Brothers and Sisters:

I would like to share with you the following meditation:

“Why are you troubled”

[Jesus said to me:] “The future is mine, what do you fear? I have given you my Mother to enlighten your way. Look at her, the Morning Star.

“Obedience will put illusions to flight. The one who gives his life to the Eternal Wisdom does not need to be clever. Think only of me, of pleasing me: I will transform you.
