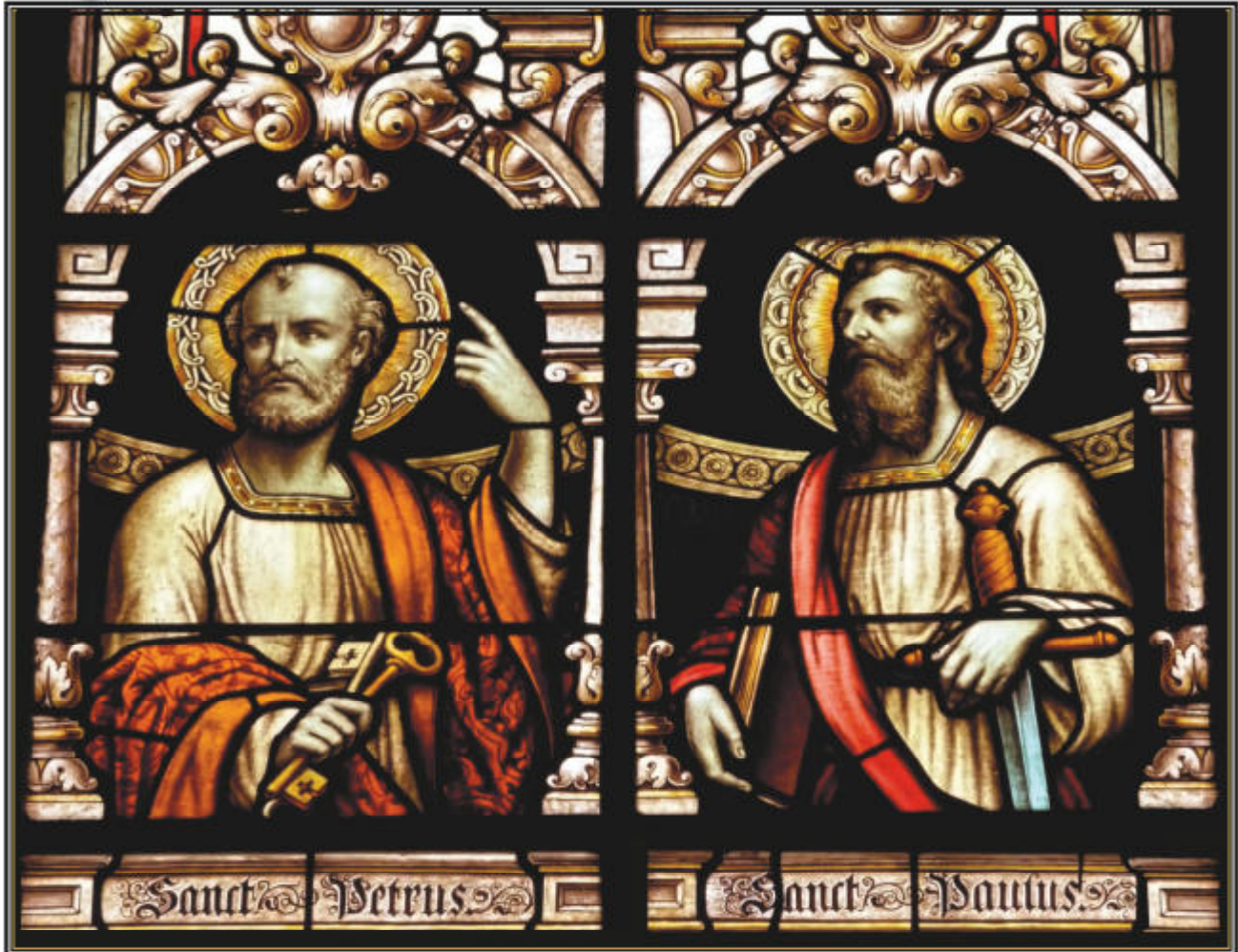

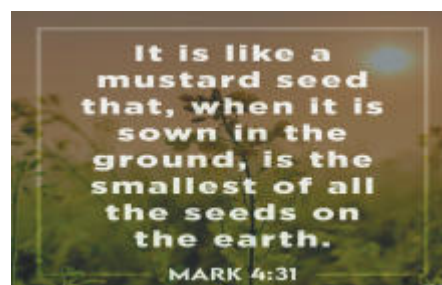

I would like to share with you the following meditation:

The Greatness of Our Christian Vocation

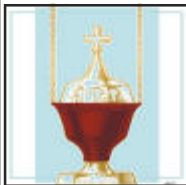

**Kip Hardgrave
Speaking June 19-20, 2021**

Kip Hardgrave graduated from the University of Notre Dame in 1967 before joining the US Marine Corps and was injured in Vietnam. Back in the States, Kip entered Maryknoll as a seminarian and studied for 4 years then went on to serve as a Maryknoll missionary in El Salvador before leaving the seminarian to marry. In 1983, Kip with his wife and son reentered Maryknoll Lay Missioners and served for 3 years in Bolivia. Upon his return to the US, Kip coordinated the refugee resettlement effort at Catholic Charities for 20 years before going into retirement. Even in retirement, Kip still helps two parishes maintain a relationship with a small town in Nicaragua.

Kip will speak at all Masses here at the Cathedral the weekend of **June 19-20, 2021** to share his mission experience as part of the Diocese of Providence's Missionary Cooperation Plan 2021.
