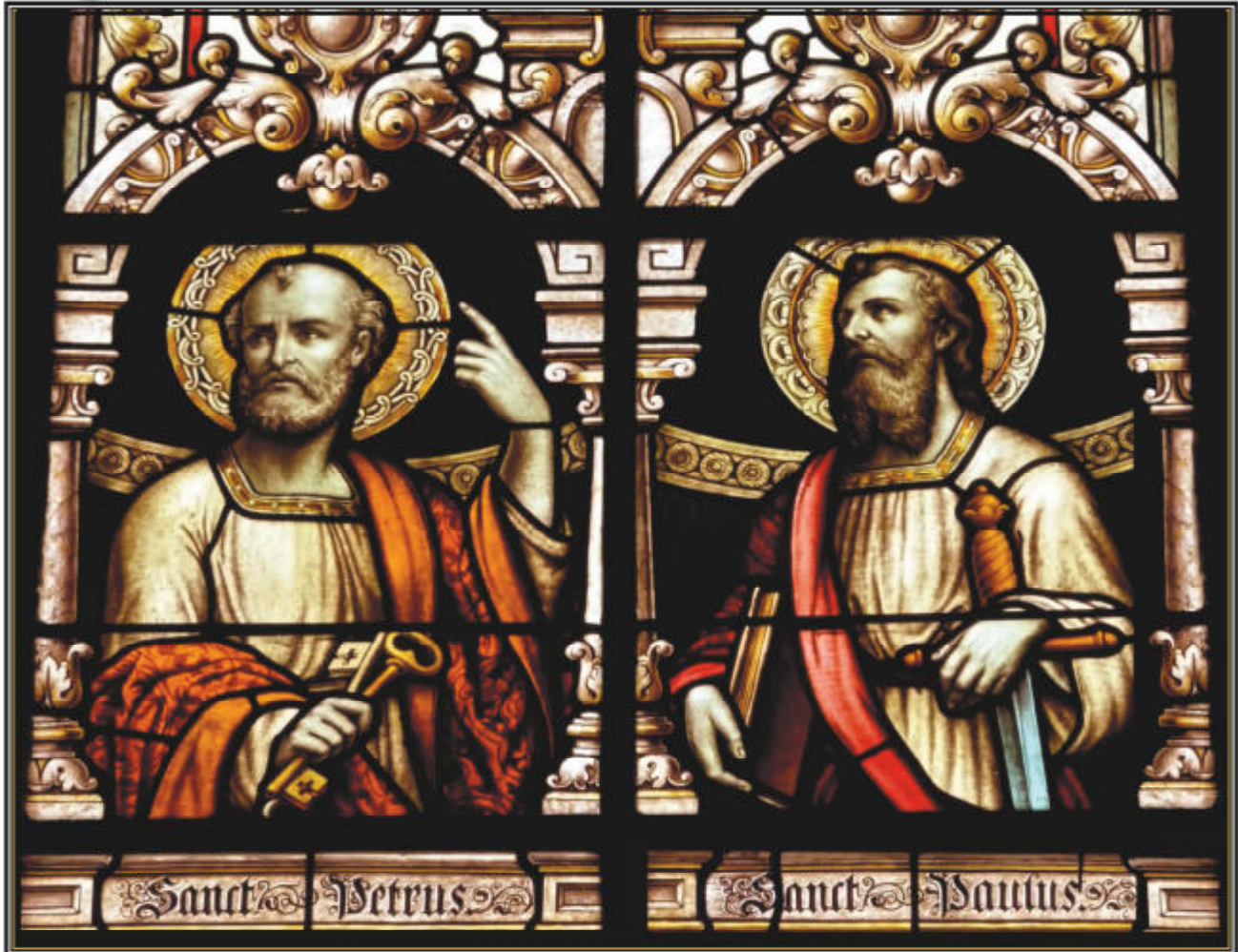

Peter's Pence Today

In the first year of his Pontificate, Pope Benedict XVI stressed the proper meaning of this offering: "Peter's Pence" is the most characteristic expression of the participation of all the faithful in the Bishop of Rome's charitable initiatives in favour of the universal Church. The gesture has not only a practical value, but also a strong symbolic one, as a sign of communion with the Pope and attention to the needs of one's brothers; and therefore your service possesses a refined ecclesial character". (Address to the Members of the St Peter Circle, 25 February 2006).

The ecclesial value of this gesture becomes evident when one considers how charitable initiatives are connatural to the Church, as the Pope stated in his first Encyclical *Deus caritas est* (25 December 2005):

"The Church can never be exempted from practicing charity as an organized activity of believers and, on the other hand, there will never be a situation where the charity of each individual Christian is unnecessary, because in addition to justice man needs, and will always need, love". This aid is always animated by that love which comes from God:

"For this reason, it is very important that the Church's charitable activity maintains all of its splendor and does not become just another form of social assistance". "The Christian's programme — the programme of the Good Samaritan, the programme of Jesus — is 'a heart which sees'. This heart sees where love is needed and acts accordingly".

Former Pontiffs have manifested their attention to the Peter's Pence Collection as a form of support given by believers to the Successors of St Peter's ministry to the universal Church. Pope John Paul II, for example, stated: "You are aware of the growing needs of the apostolate, the requirements of the ecclesial communities, especially in mission countries, and the requests for aid that come from peoples, individuals and families in precarious conditions. Many expect the Apostolic See to give them the support they often fail to find elsewhere. In this perspective the Peter's Pence Collection is a true and proper participation in the work of evangelization, especially if one considers the meaning and importance of concretely sharing in the concerns of the universal Church" (Pope John Paul II to the St Peter's Circle, 28 February 2003).
