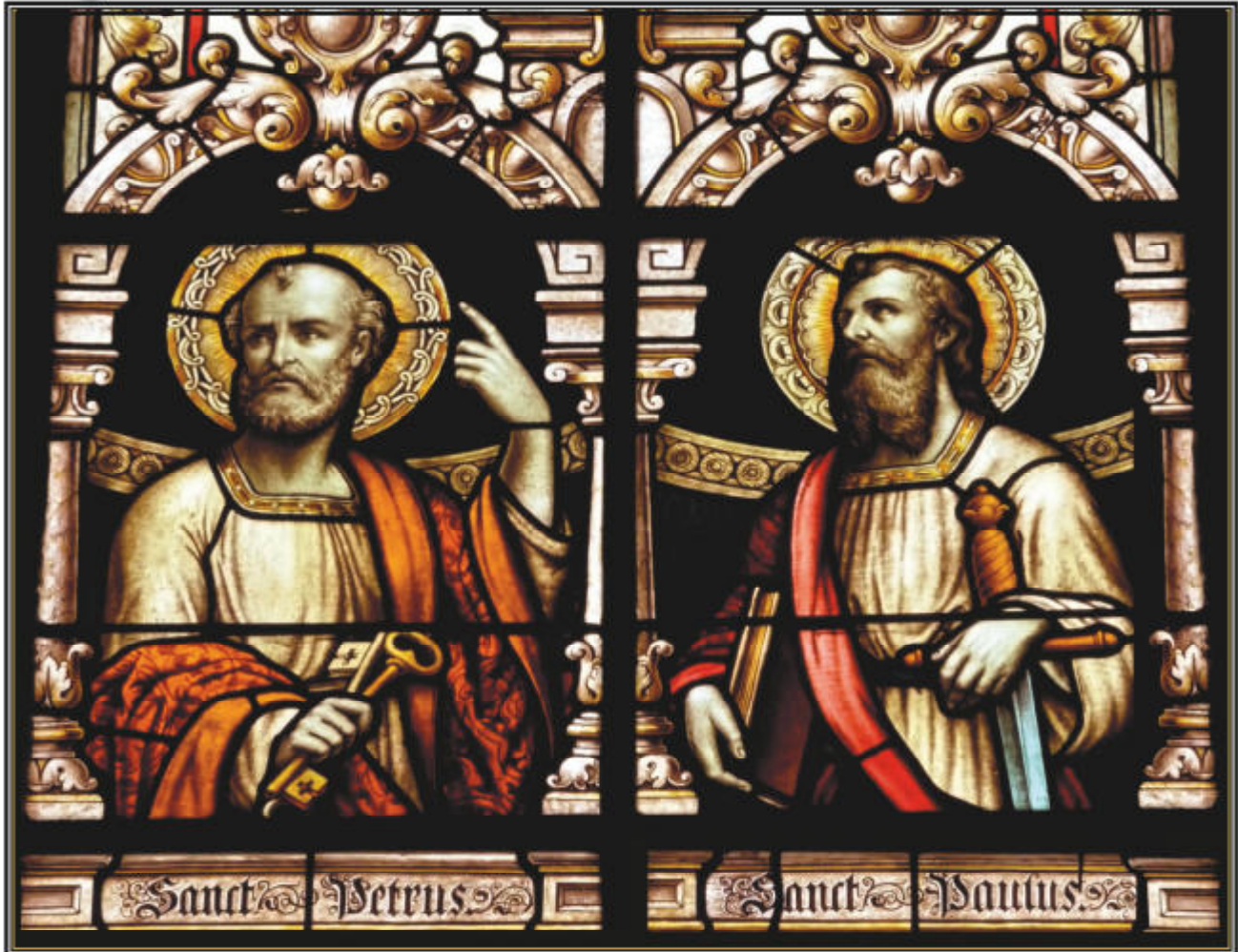

SAINT WHO?

Saints Who Were Mothers

Blessed Joan of Aza

Married Laywoman (+ c. 1190)

Feast: August 2

The beautiful and devout Joan, a noblewoman of Old Castile, Spain, was wed to the nobleman Feliz de Guzman, warden of Calaruega in Burgos. Two sons and a daughter were soon born to them. Years later, when the boys were grown and had been ordained priests, Joan went on pilgrimage to the Monastery of Silos to ask for another child. For seven days and nights, she prayed almost without ceasing. Then the beloved abbot Dominic, patron saint of the monastery, appeared to her and told her that she would have a son who would be a "light of the Church."

Sometime later, Joan had a strange dream: a black and white dog burst forth from her womb holding a flaming torch in its mouth, ready to set the whole world on fire. When her son was born, Joan named him Dominic after the holy abbot who had heard her prayer. She shared with him her love of prayer and compassion for the poor. Eventually, Dominic grew up to found the Order of Preachers, also known as the Dominicans, who seek to spread the Word of God throughout all the earth.

One of Joan's elder sons decided to join Dominic's order and is now venerated as Blessed Mannes. The early Dominicans recognized Joan as a model mother. She has been revered since the time of her death.

Pope Leo XII beatified Jane of Aza in 1828. Devotion to her has persisted through the centuries despite the poverty of records. The mother of three priest, one of whom died a death of heroic charity and two who were raised to altars of the Church, can safely be judged to have been not only a valiant woman but also a saintly one. Her picture, as that of any mother, can best be seen reflected in her sons.
