

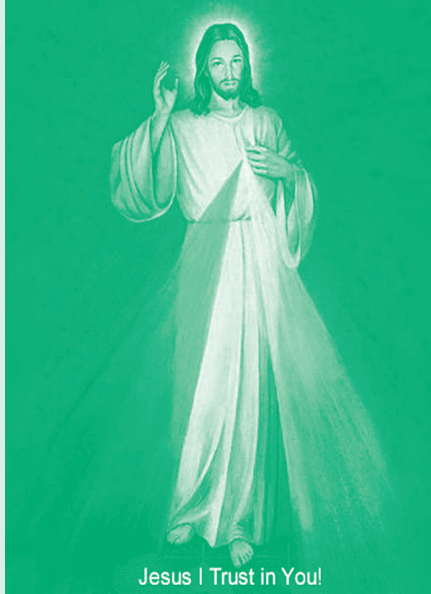

ST. ANN'S NOVENA

FRIDAY, JULY 17TH – JULY 26TH

Our annual 9 day Novena to St. Anne begins on Friday July 17TH after the Noon Mass.

On Sunday, July 26, after the 11:00 AM Mass we will have our annual procession of our young people carrying the statue of the child Jesus from St. Mary's Church to "visit" his grandmother, St. Anne. All grandchildren are invited to participate and grandparents are reminded they might want to take pictures. Our grandparents will be invited to pray a brief prayer together for our grandchildren before the procession begins. *This is expected to take about 20 minutes - after the 11:00 AM Mass - at most.* This may help our families prepare for a home celebration after we all are moved to gratitude for our living and deceased grandparents.

MISSION CO-OP WEEKEND

Next weekend, July 25/26, Fr. Isaac Honsan, representing the Archdiocese of Imphal, India, will share his missionary experience at all masses.

The mission diocese of Imphal is situated in the extreme corner of Northeast India. It was erected in 1980 comprising the entire state of Manipur. The Diocese of Imphal is home to 35 tribes of Mongolian origin, living in small villages perched on mountain tops and practicing one of the most rudimentary methods of farming called shifting cultivation. Most of the villages are not connected with all season roads and sadly lacking other basic necessities like electricity, telephones, schools, hospitals, etc.

In spite of the many challenges faced, missionary efforts are yielding an increase in vocations to the priesthood and Religious life. The proceeds of the 2015 Missionary Co-Op Collection will be used for building Ten Village Chapels for the new converts. Your generosity and prayers will be of great help for the evangelization work in the Diocese of Imphal.

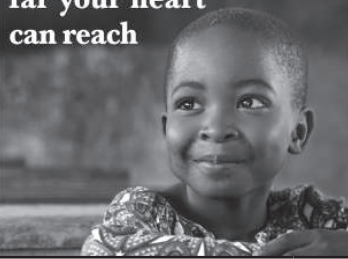
