Our Holy Father Proclaims Blessed John Paul II and Blessed John XXIII Saints!

With great joy we celebrate these two holy Popes of our lifetime who have been raised to the altars as new Saints of our Church....

Saint John XXIII

Pope John XXIII, born Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli, was Pope from 28 October 1958 to his death in 1963. Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was the fourth of fourteen children born to a family of sharecroppers that lived in a village in Lombardy. Died: June 3, 1963, Vatican City.

Saint John Paul the Great

Pope John Paul II, born Karol Józef Wojtyła. Born 18 May 1920 in Poland and died in Rome 2 April 2005. He was Pope from 16 October 1978 to his death in 2005. He was the second longest-serving pope in history and, as a Pole, the first non-Italian since Pope Adrian VI, who died in 1523.

Make the Sign of the Cross

Our Father, Hail Mary, The Apostle's Creed

On the Our Father Beads

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary Beads

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Conclude with... (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Our Merciful Lord's Words to St. Faustina

Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you ... Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death ... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between my Father and the dying person, not as the Just Judge but as the Merciful Savior ... Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from my infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy ... Through the Chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will.

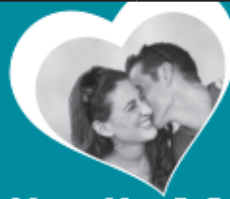
