Rejoice in the Lord always. I say it again: rejoice...! Have no anxiety at all."

These words of St. Paul may appear impossible or out of touch for our anxiety-laden hearts today. We are anxious about the possible new variants of Covid-19. We are worried about our health and the future of our loved ones. We are worried about bills to pay, personal struggles, many threats of wars, losing our personal and social freedoms, struggles in relationships, problems in the Church, etc. Yet, in the midst of all these, Holy Mother Church calls us to pause and rejoice. How can we be joyful in the midst of so many sources of anxiety?

St. Paul's words to the Philippians indicate two things that can bring us inner joy in anxious moments. The first thing is to receive and believe in joy as a gift from God. The Apostle's exhortation, "*Rejoice in the Lord*," implies that our deepest joy is *in the Lord* and in what He is doing in our lives. It is futile to seek **lasting** joy in our achievements, possessions, or conditions. Jesus warned us about seeking for joy apart from Him, "In this world, you will have tribulations; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (Jn 16:33) The Christian's joy must be firmly grounded in the One who has overcome the world and all its anxieties and worries.

But seriously, isn't "receive and believe in joy as a gift from God" a little far-fetched given the actual world we live in? Isn't it just the dreamers or the religious that this statement is meant for? Come on now, isn't it that when you come to mass on Christmas that you are supposed to hear all about love and joy but in your daily life it is all about chaos and survival? Does it seem like a total disconnect? This world is the real deal, each and every day. Why should we give attention to anything else when it is so difficult to keep up as it is?

Let's think about love. God tells us, "Love one another as we love ourselves". Was He seriously thinking about that person at work that is the most annoying person on the planet, or the kid at school that goes out of his way to be mean and disrespectful? What about that helicopter mom that makes sure her child is picked first in everything no matter what? It seems highly unfair if we are supposed to "love" those as ourselves.

Except, if we think about God's love. Do we realize that God loves us perfectly, right now, and always? God loves us perfectly before we were conceived, right now and when we get to heaven. It is easy to think that God loved us before we were conceived because we hadn't done anything yet. It is

also easy to conceive that God loves us when we are in Heaven because we must have been purified either on earth or in Purgatory. But now? Isn't it difficult to imagine God loves us perfectly when we know our own faults and sins?

That is the point. Human love has ups and downs based on actions and inactions of individuals. Someone is nice to us or does a great deed for us, of course it is easy to love them. Our children are good listeners and respectful, it is easy to love them. Our coworkers or spouse do exactly what is needed, love, love, love it. But when those things do not happen, patience runs short, tempers flare, orders are barked and our sense of control is mobilized. We need to right these wrongs, mostly because we think we can and should. After all, it is the "right" thing to do to show people the "right" path. It is always a complex situation.

We give our allegiance and respect to complexity but simplicity is the key to perfection. Peace in our hearts is born from simplicity in our lives. All the great leaders throughout history have agreed that the simplest solution is usually the best solution. The genius of God is simplicity.

If you wish to tap into the wonder, the glory and the power of God, apply simplicity to your life - and it starts with prayer. Pray simply. Our lives are suffering under the intolerable weight of ever increasing complexity. We complicate everything. And as this diseased fascination with complexity has swept across modern culture, it has also affected the way we approach prayer. Subsequently, as modern Catholics, we have deemed prayer as something beneath us, at best and worthless in many cases. Don't despise simplicity. There is real power in it.

Simplicity is one of the practical fruits of prayer. And the Rosary, reflecting on the moments of Jesus' and Mary's lives, we discover what matters least, most and a beautiful clarity emerges. Embrace the Rosary and Mary will teach you how to order your heart, mind and soul with the genius of simplicity.

How can this be? What is God saying to us? He has said that He loves us perfectly (the same before we were born, now and when we get to Heaven). Each of us is an Innkeeper who decides if there is room for Jesus in our lives now.


