Arrangements are to be made **one year** in advance.

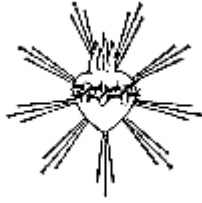

THIS SUNDAY'S GOSPEL



All Christians know that Christ suffered and died for their salvation, and that he asked his followers to take up their cross and follow him if they wished to be his disciples. The first generations of Christians fully understood this and faithfully followed him even to martyrdom. However, as time went on and opposition to the Christian faith disappeared, so too did the zeal and fervor of many Christians. For centuries we have had nominal Christians in Christ's Church -- men and women who tried to make their paradise in this world, and forgot the everlasting heaven. Our own age has seen an unprecedented increase in this falling away of Christians. Leaving aside the parts of Europe which are professedly atheist -- but where in spite of the leaders there are many sincere and devout Christians -- the number of lapsed and nominal Christians in the other Western countries is frightening. These non-practicing Christians, unwilling to carry their crosses, have decided to make this earth their paradise. They want prosperity, comfort and happiness in this world. The vast majority of them, of course, refuse to look to the future; it could be an unpleasant thought, yet they must see that in every town and village there is a mortician, an undertaker who makes a good living disposing of human "remains." Die they must; "and what then?" should be a question which overshadows their lives. Many of these people who in practice have abandoned Christianity, try to salve their consciences by devoting any time they can spare to making this planet a better place in which to live. It is an excellent aim with a possibility of success -- if the Fatherhood of God and the true brotherhood of man are upheld. But otherwise its a vain Utopia. If God, and Christ's teaching are left out of our reckoning, we shall ever have jealousies, enmities, hatred and wars. Christians have made war on Christians because neither side in the struggle was truly Christian. What chance then has the world when Christ and Christianity are banished from it? Today's thought for each one of us is this: Christ became man, suffered and died as man, for our sakes. By his resurrection He conquered death and opened heaven for us. Heaven is our true destiny. Loving God and our neighbor and carrying our cross is the only way to reach heaven. Forget this "heaven on earth" doctrine; it does not and never will exist! Accept Christ and you are accepting the Father who sent Him. He in turn will accept you.

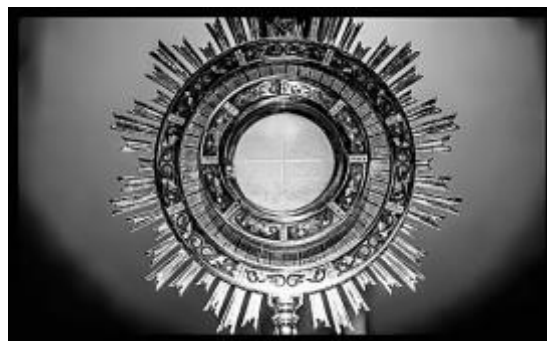

Hoy, nos cuenta el Evangelio que Jesús marchaba con sus discípulos, sorteando poblaciones, por una gran llanura. Para conocerse, nada mejor que caminar y viajar en compañía. Surge entonces con facilidad la confianza. Y la confianza es confianza. Y la confianza es comunicar amor. El amor deslumbra y asombra al descubrimos el misterio que se alberga en lo más íntimo del corazón humano. Con emoción, el Maestro habla a sus discípulos del misterio que roe su interior. Unas veces es ilusión; otras, al pensarlo, siente miedo; la mayoría de las veces sabe que no le entenderán. Pero ellos son sus amigos, todo lo que recibió del Padre debe comunicárselo y hasta ahora así ha venido haciéndolo. No le entienden pero sintonizan con la emoción con que les habla, que es aprecio, prueba de que ellos cuentan con Él, aunque sean tan poca cosa, para lograr que sus proyectos tengan éxito. Será entregado, lo matarán, pero resucitará a los tres días (cf. Mc 9,31). Muerte y resurrección. Para unos serán conceptos enigmáticos; para otros, axiomas inaceptables. Él ha venido a revelarlo, a gritar que ha llegado la suerte gozosa para el género humano, aunque para que así sea le tocará a Él, el amigo, el hermano mayor, el Hijo del Padre, pasar por crueles sufrimientos. Pero, ¡Oh triste paradoja!: mientras vive esta tragedia interior, ellos discuten sobre quien subirá más alto en el podio de los campeones, cuando llegue el final de la carrera hacia su Reino. ¿Obramos nosotros de manera diferente? Quien esté libre de ambición, que tire la primera piedra. Jesús proclama nuevos valores. Lo importante no es triunfar, sino servir; así lo demostrará el día culminante de su quehacer evangelizador lavándoles los pies.

La grandeza no está en la erudición del sabio, sino en la ingenuidad del niño. «Aun cuando supieras de memoria la Biblia entera y las sentencias de todos los filósofos, ¿de qué te serviría todo eso sin caridad y gracia de Dios?» (Tomás de Kempis). Saludando al sabio satisfacemos nuestra vanidad, abrazando al pequeñuelo estrujamos a Dios y de Él nos contagiamos, divinizándonos.

EL ESCAPULARIO

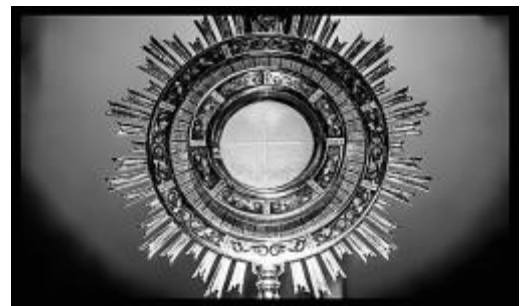


En 1251, la Virgen María, acompañada de una multitud de ángeles, se apareció a San Simón Stock, General de los Carmelitas, con el escapulario de la Orden en sus manos, y le dijo: "*Tú y todos los Carmelitas tendréis el privilegio, que quien muera con él no padecerá el fuego eterno*"; es decir, quien muera con él, se salvará. El escapulario es un signo de nuestra identidad como católicos, vinculados de íntimamente

a la Virgen María con el propósito de vivir plenamente según nuestro bautismo. Representa nuestra decisión de seguir a Jesús por María en el espíritu de los religiosos pero adaptado a la propia vocación. Esto requiere que seamos pobres (*un estilo de vida sencillo sin apegos materiales*), castos y obedientes por amor a Dios. En momentos de tentación, tomamos el escapulario en nuestras manos e invocamos la asistencia de la Madre, resueltos a ser fieles al Señor. Ella nos dirige hacia el Sagrado Corazón de su Hijo Divino y el demonio es forzado a retroceder vencido!
