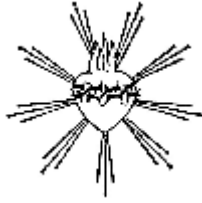

**JESUS CHRIST IS RISEN!**

I rose up and am still with Thee." After His labors and His humiliations, Christ finds rest with His Father. "I am still with Thee." This is perfect beatitude. Through His cross He entered into the possession of eternal glory. Christ has gained the crown of victory; through Christ men also



win their crowns of victory. Humanity was under a curse and subject to the wrath of God. Now that they have risen with Christ, their guilt has been destroyed. "I rose up and am still with Thee." The liturgy places these words in the mouth of the Church that she may pray them with Christ. "The earth trembled and was still when God arose in judgment." The resurrection of Christ is the judgment and condemnation of those who have turned away from God. This judgment was prefigured by the angel who passed through the land of Egypt destroying the first-born of the Egyptians. The Israelites marked the doors of their houses with the blood of the paschal lamb. We are the new Israel, and "Christ our Pasch is sacrificed." We mark ourselves with His blood, which we enjoy in the Holy Eucharist. We have been pardoned, we are saved, we shall live. "He is risen." The resurrection of Christ is a pledge of our own resurrection. It is the foundation upon which our faith rests. It is the guarantee of our redemption and God's assurance that our sins are forgiven and that we are called to eternal life. "This is the day which the Lord hath made; let us be glad and rejoice therein. Give praise to the Lord, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever. Alleluia." "Christ our Pasch is sacrificed. . . . The Lamb redeems the sheep. Christ, the innocent One, hath reconciled sinners to the Father."

## OFFERING MASSES FOR THE REPOSE OF SOULS



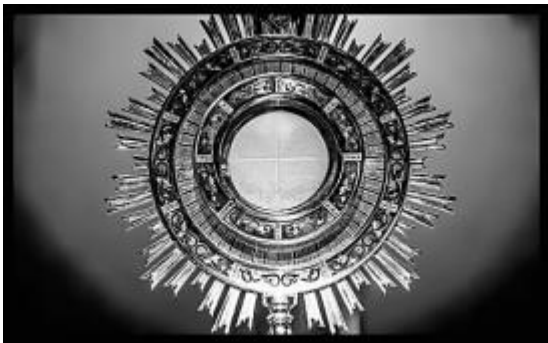

## ABRIL : MES DEL ESPIRITU SANTO

Hoy «es el día que hizo el Señor», iremos cantando a lo largo de toda la Pascua. Y es que esta expresión del Salmo 117 inunda la celebración de la fe cristiana. El Padre ha resucitado a su Hijo Jesucristo, el Amado, Aquel en quien se complace porque ha amado hasta dar su vida por todos. Vivamos la Pascua con mucha alegría.

Cristo ha resucitado:

Supo captar por la fe que aquel vacío y, a la vez, aquella sábana de amortajar y aquel sudario bien doblados eran pequeñas señales del paso de Dios, de la nueva vida. El amor sabe captar aquello que otros no captan, y tiene suficiente con pequeños signos. El «discípulo a quien Jesús quería» (Jn 20,2) se guiaba por el amor que había recibido de Cristo. “Ver y creer” de los discípulos que han de ser también los nuestros. Renovemos nuestra fe pascual. Que Cristo sea en todo nuestro Señor. Dejemos que su Vida vivifique a la nuestra y renovemos la gracia del bautismo que hemos recibido. Hagámonos apóstoles y discípulos suyos. Guiémonos por el amor y anunciemos a todo el mundo la felicidad de creer en Jesucristo. Seamos testigos esperanzados de su Resurrección.

A lo mejor no estás seguro si estás de acuerdo o entiendes algunas de las enseñanzas de la Iglesia Católica, o quizás tu fe ha sido afectada por algún escándalo? Muchas personas que abandonaron la Iglesia, por la razón que fuera, aún sienten una fuerza misteriosa que los atrae a regresar a Ella. Nosotros creemos que esta fuerza misteriosa proviene de Dios.
