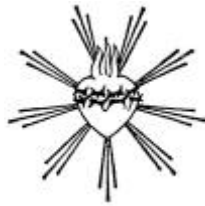

## THIS SUNDAY GOSPEL

Our Lord sent His disciples to row across the lake, knowing that they would meet strong, gale-force head-winds and be in danger. He did this because He wanted to strengthen their faith and trust in Himself. He intended to come to them at the right moment, working two miracles – walking on the water and calming the storm. This He did and the result was as He had intended – their faith in Him was strengthened, they declared He was the Messiah, the Chosen of God. Peter, already the recognized leader, and always the most daring among them, showed himself ready to risk drowning in order to prove his trust and confidence in Christ. While he trusted in Christ, all went well, but when his faith weakened he would have been lost were it not for the outstretched helping hand of his master. This was also a very necessary lesson in the education of Peter and his companions.

For us, too, there is a necessary lesson in this incident. It is that we must continue to trust in Christ and his loving Father, even when God seems to have deserted us. Most of the troubles and trials of our lives are caused by the injustice and lack of charity of our fellowmen. The remainder can be attributed to our own defects and sins or to some weakness in our mental and bodily make-up. But God foresees all these misfortunes, and can prevent them. Instead he lets them take their course, because they can and should be the means of educating us in our knowledge of life's true meaning and they should draw us closer to him.

Christ foresaw the storm and the grave risk His Apostles would run when He sent them off across the lake. But that trial and the grave danger they ran was for their own good, because they learned to realize that He was from God and they could always trust Him. Our trials and our earthly ailments are also foreseen by God and permitted by him (even if inflicted on us by a sinful fellowman) so that they will draw us closer to Him and help us on the road to heaven.

This they will do, if we accept them and bear with them until He comes to our aid. Our troubles in life are like the growing pains of our youth – they are necessary if we are to arrive at our full stature as sons of God. They form, mold and shape our religious character and bring us closer to God – if we allow them to do so. For the lukewarm Christian who rebels against God because of his earthly sufferings, they can do the opposite. He cannot see the purpose and value of suffering because he has never seriously pondered or grasped the real meaning of this life and God's loving plans for him.

As in the first reading today, God may not be in the tornadoes or earthquakes or roaring fires, nor does He cause them perhaps, but He is ever near to His true children when such calamities occur. He has a purpose in every trial or tribulation which crosses the path of our lives, a purpose always to our eternal advantage if only we will see and accept his will in these trials.

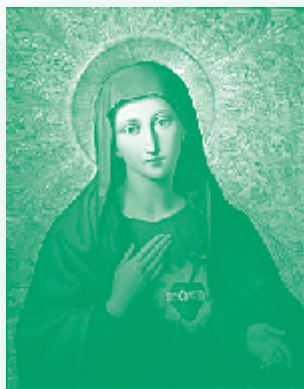

## AGOSTO: MES DEL INMACULADO CORAZON



El corazón físico de María es venerado porque está unido a su persona y es la sede de su amor (especialmente para su Hijo divino), la virtud y la vida interior. El 31 de octubre de 1942, el Papa Pío XII hizo un acto solemne de consagración de la Iglesia y del mundo entero al Inmaculado Corazón. Recordemos esta devoción durante todo el año, pero especialmente durante el mes de agosto.

### DECIMO NOVENO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

La primera lectura de los Reyes nos presenta al Profeta Elías que, cansado y desalentado por muchas tribulaciones. También nos narra la manifestación de Dios en el Monte Horeb en presencia de Elías, basada sobre la que Dios otorgó a Moisés en este mismo lugar. Usando la figura de la brisa suave, no se manifiesta ni en huracán ni en el terremoto ni en el fuego, sino en una tenue brisa, significando la acción de la ternura y mansedumbre de Dios, apuntando a la suavidad con que Dios dirige la marcha de los acontecimientos de la historia de salvación con su pueblo.

La segunda lectura de San Pablo a los Romanos nos narra la situación de sus hermanos judíos que no han aceptado a Jesús como mesías enviado por Dios, no reconocieron a su salvador. Él sabe cuál es la esperanza de Israel como pueblo elegido por Dios. Pablo afirma que Dios mueve lo que sea necesario para el bien de sus elegidos. Su raza descendiente de los primeros padres, que desde antiguo ha sido adoptado como hijo predilecto y ha experimentado la manifestación maravillosa de Dios y ha sido merecedor de la gran alianza, no aceptaron al Mesías.

El Evangelio nos relata una de las tempestades que sufrieron los Apóstoles sin que Jesús estuviera con ellos en la barca. Esta tuvo lugar después de la multiplicación de los panes y de los peces.

### MEDITACION DEL PAPA FRANCISCO SOBRE ESTE EVANGELIO

Pedro con el arrojo que le caracteriza le pide casi una prueba: "Señor si eres tú, hazme caminar hacia ti sobre las aguas"; y Jesús le dice "¡Ven!". Pedro baja de la barca y pone a caminar sobre el agua, pero el viento fuerte azota y comienza a hundirse. Entonces grita: "¡Señor, sálvame!", y Jesús le tiende la mano y lo levanta. Esta narración es una hermosa imagen de la fe del apóstol Pedro. En la voz de Jesús que le dice "Ven", él reconoce el eco del primer encuentro orillas de aquel mismo lago y en seguida, nuevamente, deja la barca y va hacia el Maestro. ¡Y camina sobre las aguas! La respuesta confiada y pronta al llamado del Señor hace cumplir siempre cosas extraordinarias. Jesús ahora mismo nos decía que nosotros somos capaces de hacer milagros con nuestra fe: la fe en Él, en su palabra, la fe en su amor. En cambio, Pedro comienza a hundirse cuando que quita la mirada de Jesús y se deja influenciar por las circunstancias que lo circundan. Pero el Señor está siempre allí, y cuando Pedro lo invoca, Jesús lo salva del peligro. En la persona de Pedro, con sus entusiasmos y debilidades, se describe nuestra fe: siempre frágil y pobre, inquieta y a pesar de todo victoriosa, la fe del cristiano camina hacia el Señor resucitado, en medio a las tormentas y peligros del mundo. 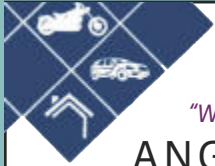
