Ben Walter Hooper

October 13, 1870– April 18, 1957

Fred Craddock was a big name among Protestant preachers. He was a great preacher and a great teacher of preachers. Years ago, Yale invited him to deliver a series of lectures on preaching in their series, Lyman Beecher Lectures. It was a great honor to be invited to deliver that series of lectures.

In one of his lectures, Craddock told a personal story from his own life. He and his wife were on vacation in the Smokey Mountains and were having dinner at a fancy restaurant called the Black Bear Inn. They were enjoying the beautiful view through the window and trying to make their way through the menu when an old man walked over to their table. The old man said, “Good evening,” and Craddock replied, “Good evening.” The old man said, “You on vacation?” and Craddock said that they were. The old man asked, “Enjoying yourself?” and Craddock allowed that they were. The old man asked, “Where are you from?” and Craddock told him that they were from Oklahoma. The old man said, “Oklahoma! I have never been to Oklahoma!” and Craddock, who was becoming a bit annoyed at the intrusion, thought, “Let’s keep it that way”—but he kept that thought to himself. The old man asked what Craddock did, and Craddock said that he taught in a seminary. The old man said, “Oh, you teach preachers! I have got a story about a preacher,” and he pulled up a chair.

Now let me tell you a little secret. If you want to see a preacher cringe, just say, “I have got a story about a preacher.” We’ve all heard the preacher stories. Most of them are not very funny. When someone says, “I have got a preacher story,” we know that we

are going to have to be polite and act like it was a good story.

The old man started by saying that he had been born in those mountains. His mother was not married, and everyone knew it. The kids had a bad name that they called him, and it hurt. He talked about recess. For most kids, recess is the best part of the school day, but that had not been true for this old man when he was a child. When recess came, he would hide in the weeds until recess ended so he would not have to endure the other kids’ cruelty.

The old man said that when he was in the seventh or eighth grade, he decided to start going to church. The preacher looked severe, and he frightened the boy and attracted him at the same time. The boy was afraid that people would wonder what a boy like him was doing in church, so he would slip in late and rush out early. But then one Sunday, he found the pew blocked. He could not get out. He broke out in a sweat, figuring that someone would ask, “What’s a boy like you doing in church?” Suddenly, he became aware of a hand on his shoulder and the preacher was standing over him. The boy cowered as he awaited the public humiliation that he was sure was coming.

Sure enough, the preacher made some comment about whose child he was—but then he said, “Well, boy, you are a child of ah—You’re a child of ah—Ah, wait!” And then the preacher said, “You are a child of God. I see a strikin’ resemblance! And he patted the boy on a shoulder and said, “Go claim your inheritance!” That was the end of the preacher story. It was a preacher story that Craddock had never heard and one that he was glad to hear.

He asked the old man his name, and the man said, “Ben Hooper.” Then Craddock remembered his father telling him about the state of Tennessee electing what they used to call an “illegitimate child” to be governor of that fine state—a governor whose name was Ben Hooper. And that was the turning point in Ben Hooper’s life. Ben Hooper became a brand new person the day that he realized that he had a father—a heavenly father.

I love that story because it reminds me that God is my father too. I have heard that all my life—that God is my father—but I sometimes have trouble believing it.

My guess is that you, too, have probably heard that you are a child of God—and that you, too, sometimes have trouble believing it.

BEREAVEMENT MINISTERS NEEDED

ALL parish and school employees, religious education volunteers, scout leaders, SVDP advocates, Hispanic ministry leaders, nursing home and hospital ministers must attend a VIRTUS Awareness Session. This is mandated by our Bishop and the Trenton Diocese in addition to being fingerprinted. Volunteers, employees and school staff need to be **recertified every four years.** School and Church employees must attend a session, even if they do not work directly with children.

Due to COVID-19, Virtus Sessions will be held online. The online option allows participants to complete initial and re-certification online at a place convenient to them within a two-week time frame. The participant will receive an email containing a link to the assigned session.

- Go to virtusonline.org and sign-in to your account OR create on new account.
- Create a VIRTUS account with a username, password and valid email address.
- Participant should **not** select a session at the time of account creation.

After you register and have a username and user ID, please call Donna (732) 462-0859 in the parish office to provide your information, so you can be scheduled for the training module.

Journeying Together through the Synod




Hopefully, you have been thinking about your own experience of journeying with the Church. We can learn so much when we reflect on our own story of faith and listen to the story of others. These

CDC guidelines for COVID-19 Booster Shots

Pfizer: individuals ages 16+ are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series.

Moderna: individuals ages 18+ are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series.

Johnson & Johnson: individuals ages 18+ are eligible for a booster shot at 2 months or more after their initial vaccine.

Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster. The CDC’s recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

The total cost to pay for the 16 teachers, 3 canteen cooks, 1 secretary and 1 guard's salaries amount to about \$14,000 for the entire year. Three years ago, we began a program whereby St. Rose parishioners could choose to sponsor the monthly

salary of one teacher at a cost of \$100 per month.

We graciously thank all those who participated. We are once again asking for sponsorship of one teacher's salary at possibly the \$100 level. Alternatively, we ask that you prayerfully consider a one-time sacrificial donation. Your donation will provide the school children with the tools they need, give them hope, and will set the foundation for a brighter future. We are mindful that your personal financial situation will dictate whether a monthly or one-time contribution is appropriate. Rest assured, however, that whether your support is monetary or spiritual, the young people of Fond Pierre and their educators are forever grateful that strangers are willing to sacrifice of themselves to give them an opportunity to lead a fulfilled life.



Ben Walter Hooper, 13 de octubre de 1870 - 18 de abril de 1957)

Fred Craddock fue un gran nombre entre los predicadores protestantes y maestro de predicadores. Yale lo invitó a dar una serie de conferencias sobre predicación las Conferencias Lyman Beecher. Fue un gran honor para él a ser invitado a dictar esas conferencias.

En una de sus conferencias, Craddock contó una historia de su propia vida. Él y su esposa estaban de vacaciones en las Montañas Smokey y cenaban en un restaurante elegante llamado Black Bear Inn. Estaban disfrutando de la hermosa vista a través de la ventana y chequeando el menú cuando un anciano se acercó a su mesa. El anciano dijo: “Buenas noches,” y Craddock respondió: “Buenas noches.” El anciano dijo: “¿Estás de vacaciones?” y Craddock dijo que sí. El anciano preguntó: “¿Estas disfrutando?” El anciano preguntó: “¿De dónde eres?” y Craddock le dijeron que eran de Oklahoma. El anciano dijo: “¡Oklahoma! ¡Nunca he estado en Oklahoma!” y Craddock, que se estaba molestando un poco por la intrusión, pensaron: “Mantengámoslo así” – pensó para sí mismo. El anciano preguntó qué hacía Craddock, y Craddock dijo que enseñaba en un seminario. El anciano dijo: “¡Oh, enseñas a predicadores! Tengo una historia sobre un predicador,” y tomo una silla y se sentó.

Ahora déjame contarte un pequeño secreto. Si quieres ver a un predicador encogerse, solo di: “Tengo una historia sobre un predicador.” Todos hemos escuchado las historias del predicador. La mayoría de ellos no son muy graciosos. Cuando alguien dice: “Tengo una historia de un predicador,” sabemos que vamos a tener que ser educados y actuar como si fuera una buena historia.

El anciano comenzó diciendo que había nacido en esas montañas. Su madre no estaba casada, y todos

lo sabían. Los niños me habían dado un sobrenombre para llamarme y me dolía. Hablé de receso. Para la mayoría de los niños, el receso es la mejor parte del día escolar, pero eso no había sido cierto para este anciano cuando era niño. Cuando llegaba el recreo, se escondía en la maleza hasta que terminaba el recreo para no tener que soportar la crueldad de otro niño.

El anciano dijo que cuando estaba en séptimo u octavo grado, decidió empezar a ir a la iglesia. El predicador parecía severo y lo asustó al niño y lo atrajo al mismo tiempo. El niño temía que la gente se preguntara qué estaba haciendo un niño como él en la iglesia, como el para que saliera tarde y saliera corriendo temprano.

Pero luego, un domingo, encontró un banco bloqueado la salida. No pudo salir. Comenzó a sudar, pensando que alguien le preguntaría: “¿Qué está haciendo un niño como tú en la iglesia?” De repente, se dio cuenta de una mano sobre su hombro y el predicador estaba de pie a su lado. El niño se acobardaba esperando la humillación pública que estaba seguro que le vendría.

Por supuesto, el predicador hizo algún comentario sobre de quién era – pero luego dijo: “Bueno, chico, eres un hijo de ah – Eres un hijo de ah – ¡Ah, espera!” Y luego el predicador dijo: “Eres un hijo de Dios. ¡Veo un parecido sorprendente!” Y acarició al niño en un hombro y dijo: “¡Ve a reclamar tu herencia!” Ese fue el final de la historia del predicador. Era una historia de predicador que Craddock nunca había oído y que estaba contento de escuchar.

Le preguntó al anciano su nombre, y el hombre dijo: “Ben Hooper.” Luego Craddock recordó que su padre le habló sobre el estado de Tennessee eligiendo lo que solían llamar un “hijo ilegítimo” para ser gobernador de ese estado – un gobernador cuyo nombre era Ben Hooper. Y ese fue el punto del cambio en la vida de Ben Hooper. Ben Hooper se convirtió en una persona completamente nueva el día que se dio cuenta de que tenía un padre – un padre celestial.

Me encanta esa historia porque me recuerda que Dios también es mi padre. He oído eso toda mi vida – que Dios es mi padre – pero a veces tengo problemas para creerlo.

Supongo que tú también probablemente hayas oído que eres un hijo de Dios – y que tú también tienes problemas para creerlo.


