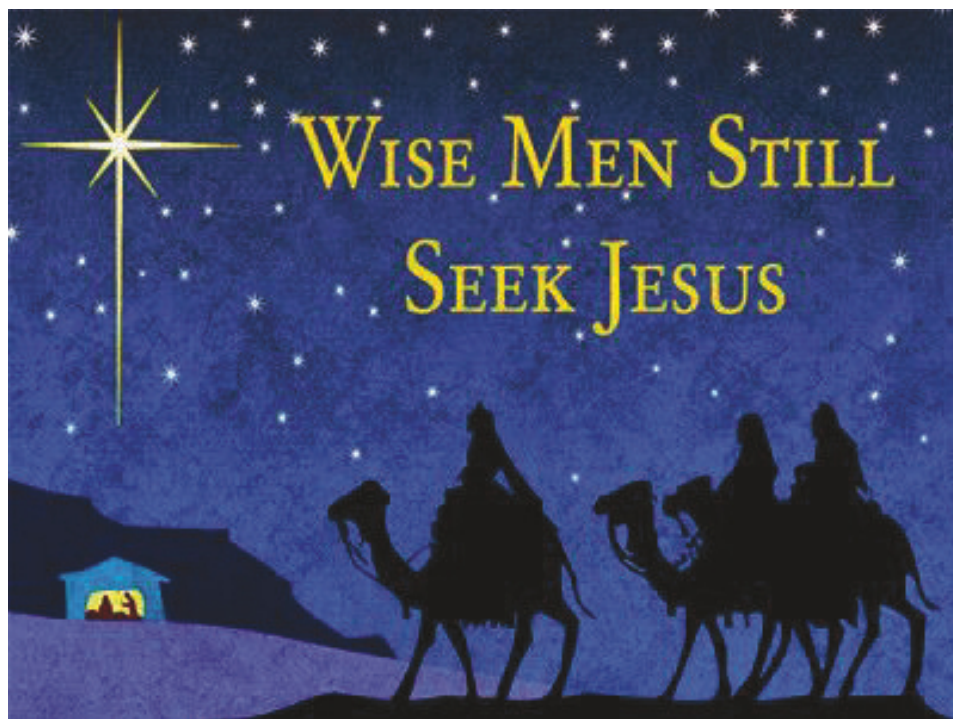

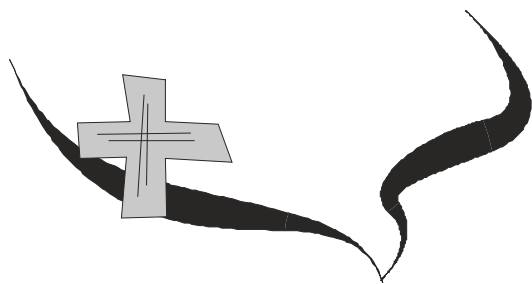

Feast of the Three Kings

Epiphany, the coming of the Three Wise Men, is a very important feast around the world. Just as we give presents to each other on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, in some countries the presents are exchanged on Epiphany, representing the gifts of Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh, brought as gifts to the child Jesus.

People through the centuries have given these Kings many occupations. Some traditions call them astrologers, some scholars or wise men, others, strangers from the east. However, the most significant thing about them, from St. Matthew, was that they were Gentiles, people who were not Jewish from birth. This is important because in Jesus' day the Jewish people felt that only they would be saved by God.

St. Matthew was insisting that Jesus did not come to save only the Jewish people, but to save all people. To make his point, he put non-Jews at the scene of Jesus' birth – the Three Wise Men. In doing this he was saying that we Gentiles, non-Jews, were with Jesus from the very beginning and those Wise Men were our representatives. As a result, we have a right to be Jesus' followers and be with him forever.

Blessing of the Doors

With chalk, the initials of the Three Kings' are placed on the frame above the door of your house along with the year: 22 + C + M + B + 22 as a sign that just as the Three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior and Balathazar found Jesus, so anyone entering this home will find Christ here as well.

Prayer for Home Blessing:

Oh God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live and visit here. Fill them with the light of Christ, that their concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Mother Teresa once visited a poor man in Melbourne, Australia. He was living in a basement room, which was in a terrible state of neglect. There was no light in the room. He did not seem to have a friend in the world. She started to clean and tidy the room. At first, he protested, "Leave it alone. It is alright as it is." But she went ahead anyway.

As she cleaned, she chatted with him. Under a pile of rubbish, she found an oil lamp covered with dust. She cleaned it and discovered that it was beautiful. And she said to him, "You have got a beautiful lamp here. How come you never lighted it?" "Why should I light it? No one ever comes to see me." "Will you promise to light it if one of my sisters comes to see you?" "Yes," he replied. "If I hear a human voice, I will light the lamp."

Two of Mother Teresa's sisters began to visit him regularly. Things gradually improved for him. Every time the sisters came to visit him, he had the lamp lit. Then one day he said to them: "Sisters, I will be able to manage myself from now on. Do me a favor. Tell the first sister who came to see me that the light she lit in my life is still burning."

The light that God lit to announce the coming of his son is still burning. The Magi followed the path of the great light and reached the cradle of Jesus. For the last twenty centuries many have followed the footprints of the Magi. Today, Jesus stands before us declaring, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."



The recent "40 Days For Life" peaceful and prayerful protest at the Shrewsbury Planned Parenthood abortion center was successful. We had all our shifts covered for the full six Fridays and received a lot of public attention. Thanks for participating. We will participate again during Lent in 2022.

There is a very active group of about 18 to 24 pro-lifers that meets every Saturday morning at the PP abortion center, 69 Newman Springs Road, Shrewsbury, picketing and saying the rosary, from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM. All are welcome to join.

ALL parish and school employees, religious education volunteers, scout leaders, SVDP advocates, Hispanic ministry leaders, nursing home and hospital ministers must attend a VIRTUS Awareness Session. This is mandated by our Bishop and the Trenton Diocese in addition to being fingerprinted. Volunteers, employees and school staff need to be **recertified every four years.** School and Church employees must attend a session, even if they do not work directly with children.

Due to COVID-19, Virtus Sessions will be held online. The online option allows participants to complete initial and re-certification online at a place convenient to them within a two-week time frame. The participant will receive an email containing a link to the assigned session.

- Participant should **not** select a session at the time of account creation.

HAITI How can You Make a Difference ?



The riots in Haiti are making life even more difficult for our brothers and sisters as streets close and rampant destruction causes mayhem in the capital, Port-Au-Prince. Although our friends in Fond Pierre are not subjected to the violence and unrest, they are negatively impacted by the economic fall-out from the disturbances. Father Daisma also wanted to thank you on behalf of the people of Fond-Pierre for your past generous support.

The focus of our twinning relationship with St. Peter's Church, which spans over a decade, continues to be the education of the more than 360 students that make up the



parochial school. The total cost to pay for the 16 teachers, 3 canteen cooks, 1 secretary and 1 guard's salaries amount to about \$14,000 for the entire year. Three years ago, we began a program whereby St. Rose parishioners could choose to sponsor the monthly salary of one teacher at a cost of \$100 per month.

We graciously thank all those who participated. We are once again asking for sponsorship of one teacher's salary at possibly the \$100 level. Alternatively, we ask that you prayerfully consider a one-time sacrificial donation. Your donation will provide the school children with the tools they need, give them hope, and will set the foundation for a brighter future. We are mindful that your personal financial situation will

dictate whether a monthly or one-time contribution is appropriate. Rest assured, however, that whether your support is monetary or spiritual, the young people of Fond Pierre and their educators are forever grateful that strangers are willing to sacrifice of themselves to give them an opportunity to lead a fulfilled life.

If the exact date and time you requested is not available, the closest available Mass date will be assigned. Please indicate which is more important, the date or the time.

Please enclose a self-addressed envelope if you want notification of the days and times assigned.

If you are requesting Mass cards, you will be contacted as to when they will be available in the parish office for you to pick up.

We thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation in our effort to serve the needs of our parish as compassionately and efficiently as possible.

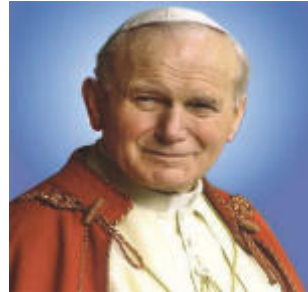

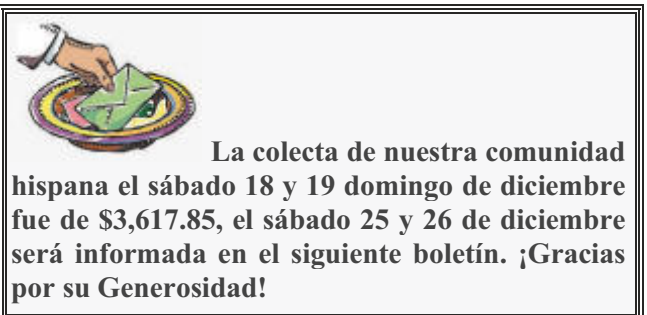

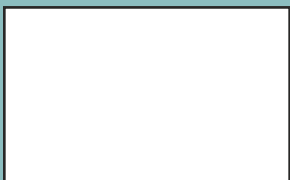
