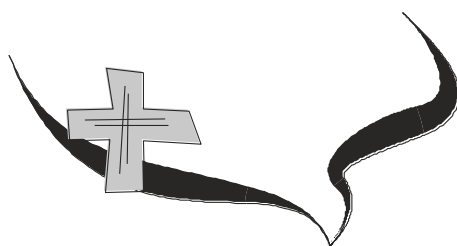

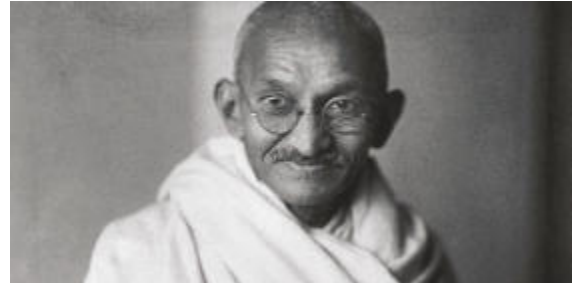

### The Baptism of the Lord - Year C

Mahatma Gandhi was not a Christian, yet he was one of the most Christ-like people of this century. Gandhi was a staunch opponent of India's iniquitous caste system. He referred to it as 'a blot on the soul of India.'

He especially abhorred the treatment meted out to the untouchables—those who belong to the lower caste. They were barred from entering the temples. In towns and cities, they were confined to the slums and allowed to perform only the most menial jobs. In the country, they were forbidden the use of the wells.

On his journeys through India, Gandhi was warmly welcomed by the people. When he entered a village, the head of the village would invite him to stay in his house for the night, where he would be assured of a bath, good food, and a decent night's rest.

But Gandhi politely refused the offer. He asked, "Where are your untouchables? I will stay with them." And he did, even though his action shocked many. The reaction of the untouchables was immediate and wholehearted. They embraced him and took him to their hearts. He was now one of them. There was no need, no point anymore, in keeping his distance. The untouchables had someone who could talk with authority about brokenness, rejection, and public shame.

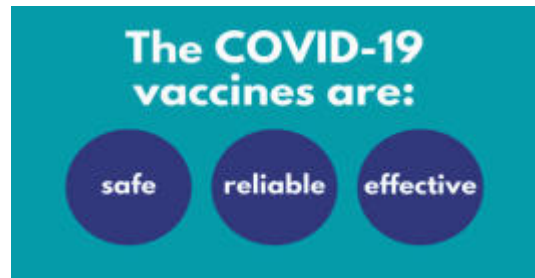

The riots in Haiti are making life even more difficult for our brothers and sisters as streets close and rampant destruction causes mayhem in the capital, Port-Au-Prince. Although our friends in Fond Pierre are not subjected to the violence and unrest, they are negatively impacted by the economic fall-out from the disturbances. Father Daisma also wanted to thank you on behalf of the people of Fond-Pierre for your past generous support.

The focus of our twinning relationship with St. Peter's Church, which spans over a decade, continues to be the education of the more than 360 students that make up the



parochial school. The total cost to pay for the 16 teachers, 3 canteen cooks, 1 secretary and 1 guard's salaries amount to about \$14,000 for the entire year. Three years ago, we began a program whereby St. Rose parishioners could choose to sponsor the monthly salary of one teacher at a cost of \$100 per month.

We graciously thank all those who participated.

We are once again asking for sponsorship of one teacher's salary at possibly the \$100 level. Alternatively, we ask that you prayerfully consider a one-time sacrificial donation. ### SANTA TERESITA DEL NIÑO JESUS

**Canonización:** 17 de mayo 1925 por el papa Pío XI

Cada primero de octubre se celebra su festividad, ella es la patrona Universal de las misiones.

Santa Teresita ordeno que hubiera numerosos conventos y renovó a la iglesia.

El milagro que ella hizo con sus oraciones fue curar enfermos por ejemplo la curación de una joven llamada Charles Anne que fue víctima de hemoptisis pulmonar.

Teresa fue bautizada dos días después de su nacimiento en la iglesia de Nuestra Señora de Alenzón. A los 7 años en 1880 Teresa se confesó por primera vez, a los ocho años y medio, el 3 de octubre de 1881, Teresa entro en el colegio de las Benedictinas en Lisieux.

En diciembre de 1882 la salud de Teresa empieza a empeorar de manera extraña, sufre continuamente de dolores de cabeza, dolores en el costado, comia poco y dormia mal y se convirtió en la monja del Carmelo para orar por todos los pecadores.

El 10 de enero de 1889 tomo los hábitos de la orden en la capilla del monasterio en presencia de su padre, hermanos y resto de la familia. En la misma ceremonia además de recibir el velo de novicia también cambio su nombre por el de Teresa del Nino Jesús.

Durante la Cuaresma de 1896 hacia los ejercicios espirituales y el ayuno durante la noche del jueves al viernes Santo cuando sufrió su primer ataque de hemoptisis

También en ese mismo año experimento una oscuridad interior, que la llevo a renovar y fortalecer su fe hasta el punto de querer morir de amor por Jesús. *“Para mi orar consiste en elevar el*

*corazón, en levantar los ojos al cielo, en manifestar mi gratitud y mi amor lo mismo en el gozo que en la prueba”*

En enero 1897 escribió “yo creo que mi vida no durara mucho tiempo”.

El segundo milagro fue para Luis de San German sufría de una infección del estómago ya muy avanzada para una cirugía.

Teresa dejo 21 oraciones, 8 recreaciones piadosas y uno de los clásicos espirituales más famosos es Historia de un alma que fue traducida a 42 idiomas. En julio 1897 cuando ya estaba en sus últimos meses su hermana Paulina le dijo que su confianza en Dios se debía a que ella había sido preservada del pecado mortal.

Cerca de la monumental Basílica que fue construida en su honor en el cementerio reposaron sus restos durante 26 años.

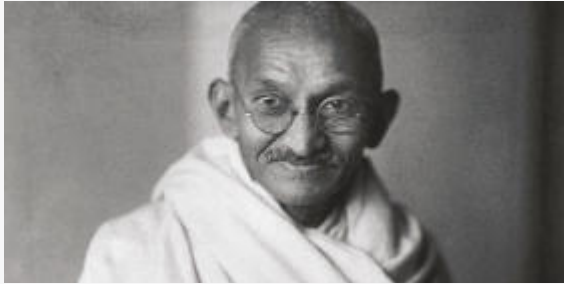

Mahatma Gandhi no era cristiano, pero fue una de las personas más parecidas a Cristo de este siglo. Gandhi era un firme oponente del inicuo sistema de las castas de la India. Se refirió a ello como "una mancha en el alma de la India".

Aborrecía especialmente el trato dado a los intocables, aquellos que pertenecen a la casta inferior. Se les prohibió entrar en los templos. En los pueblos y ciudades, estaban confinados a los barrios marginales y se les permitía realizar solo los trabajos más serviles. En el país, se les prohibió el uso de los pozos.

En sus viajes por la India, Gandhi fue recibido calurosamente por la gente. Cuando entraba en una aldea, el jefe de la aldea lo invitaba a quedarse en su casa por la noche, donde se le aseguraba un baño, buena comida y una noche de descanso decente.

Pero Gandhi rechazó cortésmente la oferta. Preguntó: "¿Dónde están tus intocables? Me quedaré con ellos." Y lo hizo, a pesar de que su acción sorprendió a muchos. La reacción de los intocables fue inmediata y sincera. Lo abrazaron y lo llevaron en sus corazones. Ahora era uno de ellos. Ya no había necesidad de mantener su distancia. Los intocables tenían a alguien que podía hablar con autoridad sobre la ruptura, el rechazo y la vergüenza pública.

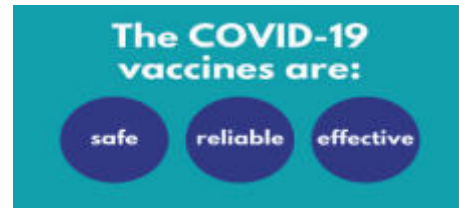
