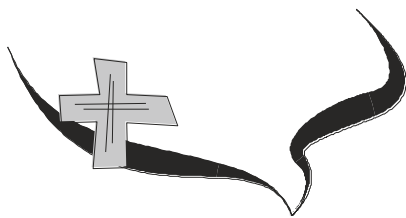

When U. S. Presidents are sworn into office, it is customary for them to deliver inaugural speeches. These addresses usually outline the challenges which face them and the ideals by which they will try to govern. Such inaugural speeches are more often remembered, however, for their inspirational sayings.

We recall, for example, Franklin Delano Roosevelt's words in 1933: "This great nation will endure as it has endured. The only thing we have to fear is fear itself."

John F. Kennedy's exhortation in 1961 is equally memorable: "And so, my fellow Americans, ask not what your country can do for you. Ask what you can do for your country."

More recently, we call to mind Ronald Reagan's American Song theme in 1985: "Hopeful, big-hearted, idealistic—daring, decent and fair. That's our heritage, that's our song...we raise our voices to the God who is the author of this most tender music."

Today's gospel reads somewhat like one of these presidential inaugural addresses. Jesus had already been appointed officially by his Father to his office as Messiah when he was baptized. He now begins his teaching ministry by standing up in public in a synagogue and making his inaugural address. In his speech he quotes the prophet Isaiah to outline the challenges facing him. Then he makes the dramatic and daring declaration that all this is happening right then and right there, even as they listen.

### FEAST OF ST. BLAISE

Thursday, February 3, is the Feast of St. Blaise. Throats will be blessed at the 8:30 morning Mass and after all the weekend Masses, February 5/6.

Little is known about St. Blaise other than he was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the early fourth century. Legend tells the story of an anxious mother who hurried to St. Blaise with her little son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. Saint Blaise called for two candles, lit them, held them in the form of a cross under the child's chin, recited prayers and blessed the boy. Immediately, the bone loosened and was removed.

One reason for St. Blaise's popularity arose from the fact he was a physician who was known for performing miraculous cures. Therefore, those who were sick, especially with throat ailments, invoked his intercession. That is why on his Feast Day we have our throats blessed and ask him to protect us from all evil, physical, spoken and spiritual, which may attack the throat.

### HAITI How can You Make a Difference ?



The riots in Haiti are making life even more difficult for our brothers and sisters as streets close and rampant destruction causes mayhem in the capital, Port-Au-Prince. Although our friends in Fond Pierre are not subjected to the violence and unrest, they are negatively impacted by the economic fall-out from the disturbances. Father Daisma also wanted to thank you on behalf of the people of Fond-Pierre for your past generous support.

The focus of our twinning relationship with St. Peter's Church, which spans over a decade, continues to be the education of the more than 360 students that make up the



parochial school. The total cost to pay for the 16 teachers, 3 canteen cooks, 1 secretary and 1 guard's salaries amount to about \$14,000 for the entire year. Three years ago, we began a program whereby St. Rose parishioners could choose to sponsor the monthly salary of one teacher at a cost of \$100 per month.

We graciously thank all those who participated. We are once again asking for sponsorship of one teacher's salary at possibly the \$100 level. Alternatively, we ask that you prayerfully consider a one-time sacrificial

donation. Your donation will provide the school children with the tools they need, give them hope, and will set the foundation for a brighter future. Cuando los presidentes de Estados Unidos prestan juramento, de costumbre pronuncien discursos inaugurales. Estos generalmente describen los desafíos que enfrentan y los ideales por los que tratarán de gobernar. Sin embargo, estos discursos inaugurales son recordados con más frecuencia por sus inspiradores.

Recordamos, por ejemplo, las palabras de Franklin Delano Roosevelt en 1933: "Esta gran nación perdurará como ha perdurado. Lo único que tenemos que temer es el miedo mismo."

La exhortación de John F. Kennedy en 1961 es igualmente memorable: "Y así, mis compatriotas estadounidenses, no pregunten qué puede hacer su país por ustedes. pregúntese usted qué puede hacer por su país."

Más recientemente, recordamos el tema de la Canción Americana de Ronald Reagan en 1985: "Esperante, de gran corazón, idealista, atrevido, decente y justo. Esa es nuestra herencia, esa es nuestra canción... elevamos nuestras voces al Dios que es el autor de esta música tan tierna."

*En el evangelio de hoy se lee algo así como uno de estos discursos presidenciales inaugurales. Jesús ya había sido designado oficialmente por su Padre para su cargo como Mesías cuando fue bautizado. Ahora comienza su ministerio publico de enseñanza poniéndose de pie en público en una sinagoga y haciendo su discurso inaugural. En su discurso cita al profeta Isaías para mencionar los desafíos que enfrenta. Luego hace la declaración dramática y atrevida de que todo esto está sucediendo en ese momento y allí mismo, incluso mientras escuchan.*

### *Santa Teresa de Calcuta*



**Fecha de Nacimiento:** 26 de agosto 1910  
**Fecha de Fallecimiento:** 5 de septiembre, 1997  
**Causa de muerte:** insuficiencia cardiaca

Santa Teresa de Calcuta fue líder y fundadora de las misioneras de la caridad y premio novel de la paz en 1979 y en 2016 fue declarada Santa por el papa Francisco. Anjeze Gonxhe Bojaxhiu, fue el nombre de nacimiento. Era la hija menor de un matrimonio acomodado.

Siendo aun niña ingreso en la congregación Mariana de las Hijas de Maria. A los 18 años abandono para siempre su ciudad natal y viajo hasta Dublín para profesar en la congregación de Nuestra señora de Loreto.

Durante casi 20 años trabajo como maestra en la St. Mary's High School de Calcuta. Sin embargo, la profunda impresión que le causó la miseria que observaba en las calles de la ciudad la movió a solicitar a Pio XII el permiso para abandonar la orden y entregarse por completo a la causa de los menesterosos. Santa Teresa de Calcuta pronunció entonces el que sería el principio fundamental de su mensaje y de su acción: "Quiero llevar el amor de Dios a los pobres más pobres; quiero demostrarles que Dios ama al mundo y que los ama a ellos."

Ella atendía a miles de desheredados y moribundos sin importarle si profesaban el cristianismo u otra religión: "Para nosotras no tiene la menor importancia la fe que profesan las personas a las que prestamos asistencia. Nuestro criterio de ayuda no son las creencias, sino la necesidad. Jamás permitimos que alguien se aleje de nosotras sin sentirse mejor y más feliz, pues hay en el mundo otra pobreza peor que la material: el desprecio que los marginados reciben de la sociedad, que es la más insoportable de las pobreza."

**Unos de los milagros que hizo Santa Teresa de Calcuta**

Una mujer que se recuperó de un tumor en el abdomen del tamaño de un balón y un hombre que se curó de una infección en el cerebro fueron los dos milagros de la Madre Teresa de Calcuta en su camino a los altares.

Años después de su muerte, en octubre del 2003, y coincidiendo con la celebración del 25° aniversario del pontificado de Juan Pablo II, la Madre Teresa de Calcuta fue beatificada en una multitudinaria misa a la que acudieron fieles de todas partes del mundo. A finales de 2015, el Vaticano aprobó su canonización; el 4 de septiembre de 2016 fue canocizada.

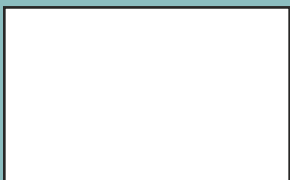
