# Families Serving Families

## Donated Funds are Welcome!



Often, we are asked whether the Parish Pantry accepts monetary donations, in addition to donated food. The answer is YES! Consider this:

- Food Bank of the Rockies increased the variety of wholesale-priced non-perishable foods to better assist food pantries during the health crisis. Meanwhile, donations of these foods became less available. Now, we are spending most of our donated funds on canned & dry foods, purchased from FBR.
- We continue to purchase produce and fresh eggs as needed each week. Additional funds are spent on toilet tissue, when needed for our distributions.
- At tax filing time, if you wish to deduct your contributions to the pantry, it is simpler to track a cancelled check than it is to track your grocery store receipts. Plus, the Parish accounting office provides annual reports of donations to our Parishioners.
- Donated funds should be marked "Parish Pantry". Checks or envelopes may be dropped in the Mass collection bins or delivered to the parish office. You may also direct funds to the Pantry through Faith Direct, the Parish e-giving program.

Of course, donated food is always welcome. **Non-Perishable** food may be placed in the wooden collection box near the drinking fountain in the church or dropped into the shopping baskets located at the west end of Marian Hall. Perishable foods may be brought to Ave Maria Hall on Monday mornings, between 7:30 – 9:00 AM. Thank you to all who support this outreach ministry!

## Safety Concern and request for assistance



# Worship and Reflection

## Gospel Meditation

What are the little ones? They are the poor, the marginalized, the women and men at the well, the Zacchaeus' looking for Jesus from a tree, those mired in sin, the blind who want to see, and the lame who want to walk. They are the lepers and the different ones who have been told that they are unclean, and the ones who suffer from abuse and grave injustices and oppression. They are children who want nothing more than to be loved and enjoy celebrating their innocence. These are all the little ones and they are all vulnerable. Life already brings them burdens, we don't need to add to them.

St. Oscar Romero said, "When the church hears the cry of the oppressed it cannot but denounce the social structures that give rise to and perpetuate the misery from which the cry arises."

Why are so many people still so gravely hurting? We have the resources and the means to make things better. We choose not to. There are still those things called greed, pride, lust, apathy, jealousy, gluttony, and anger that prevent us from seeing each other and people to be loved and not objects to be used. Is this how God intended things to be?



God loves what is good and upright. It doesn't matter who did it or where it came from. In God's eyes, the end result is always faith, hope, and love. Those will always unite a person with God. We fill our lives with many things that are not good either for ourselves or for others. All of us have to work to discover what it is, exactly, that leads to the world's brokenness. There are people, systems, and ideologies in place that foster oppression and injustice rather than equity and fairness. Sadly, our complacency can be the greatest evil. Turning a blind eye, ignoring the truth, and believing that we are helpless to fix so great a problem, does little to move us closer to the kingdom of God. As members of the Body of Christ, we cannot condone anything that keeps people in misery.

As it is said, charity begins at home. Perhaps a good place to start is with our own households and making sure their foundations are properly laid.


## CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

# Fatherhood

At the Marian Festival on September 12th we announced that the theme for this year will be Fatherhood. After many difficulties this past year with the threat of Covid, we want to begin a new year with a new and important focus. The Marian Festival was a special day to celebrate Mary and to ask for her help in beginning our year, to lead us to St. Joseph in the year that the Holy Father has dedicated to him.

During this year we will see that Joseph has an important message to communicate to us: being a father is an answer to a divine vocation, a yes to a divine promise that will fulfil our lives. The man who becomes a father, grows in his humanity till he becomes more like God, the Father. So, it is for this reason that we want to propose to the parish a year dedicated to fatherhood.

To understand the importance of fatherhood, we must ask ourselves, why are today's men afraid of being fathers? Some time ago, it was taken for granted that a man would become a father. The normal way of living was to get a job and to get married, and then it was taken for granted that he would become a father. Today, becoming a father is the fruit of a difficult decision, that is taken with a lot of consideration, because today we have many fears:

- Superficial fears related with the material resources that are needed to become a father. Can I earn enough money? Can I afford a house that is big enough to raise a family?
- Significant fears related with the skills needed to raise and to educate a child
- Important fears related with the relationship with the mother. Can we work together to raise and educate our children? Perhaps, here we see that feminism has introduced a distrust between mother and father that breaks their harmony.
- Powerful fears related with the difficulty of accepting radical newness in our lives, because the child is always someone new who will challenge our life. Every child always forces us to go out of our comfort zone
- Deep fears related with the holy fear of God, just as St. Joseph had. His problem was not suspicion surrounding the integrity of Mary, but more his place in a family where the Son of God is the son of his wife: How could I possibly educate him?

Today, husbands need to listen also to the angel's words: Don't fear being a father! Why? Because becoming a father is not only the fruit of a difficult choice, but the answer to a divine vocation. It is a yes to a promise of God. And you are not alone. God will accompany you.

## How do you see fatherhood in this picture?



Van Gogh's painting "First Steps" helps us to understand the father's mission. In the picture, the mother takes the little girl to see the father who is working in the orchard, holding her by the arms. And now the father, having put down his hoe, calls to the little girl and opens his arms for her to come to him. The little girl could trip and hurt herself but the mother must agree to let go of the child so that she can learn to walk. The father encourages the mother because he shows himself capable of withstanding the daughter's wounds. It is in this mutual trust and acceptance of the different roles that the child will learn to walk, will have a new space, and will be able to face the future as an adventure. The father is the one who opens a future for his family.


