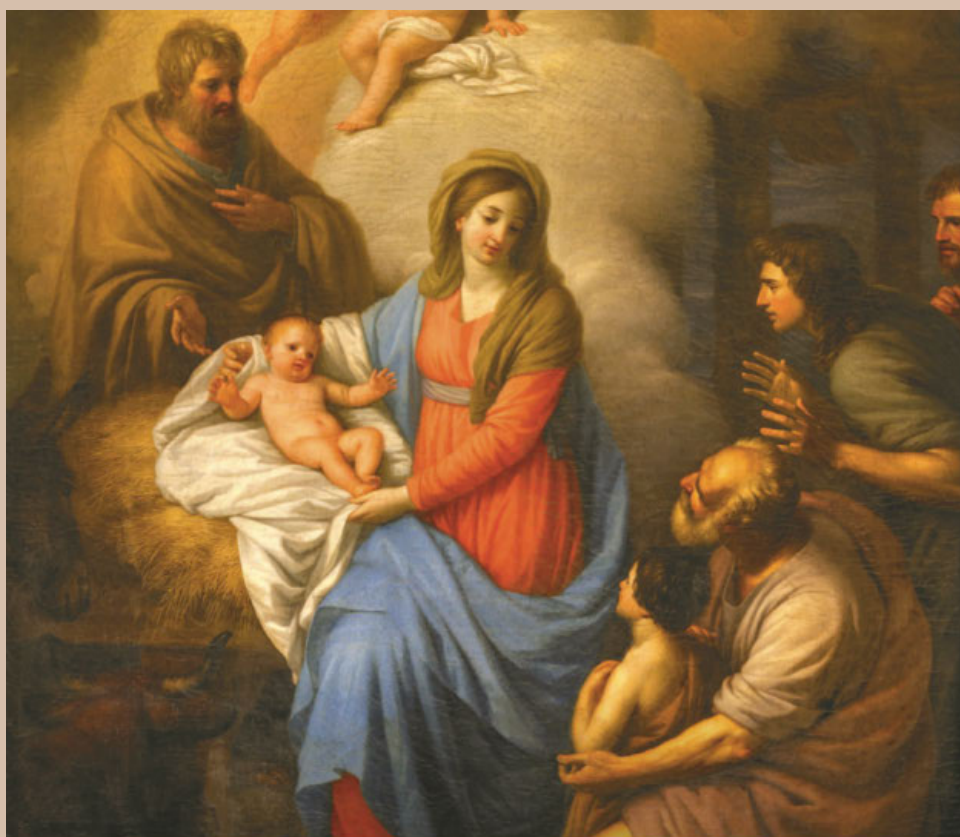

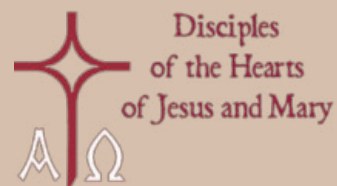

Saturday, January 1st 4:30pm Anticipatory for Epiphany

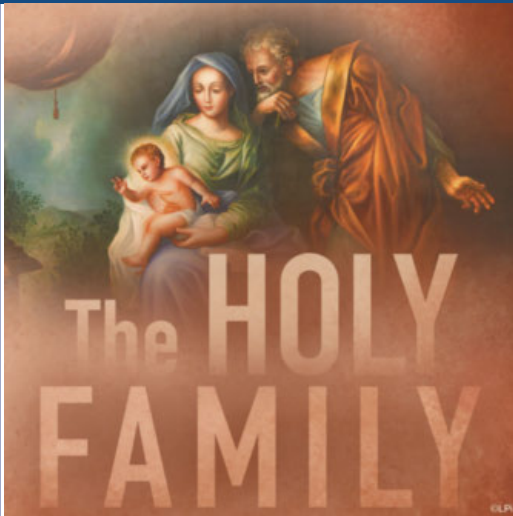
Mary's Little Flock Nursery Closed

End-of-year contributions

As the end of 2021 approaches, you may be thinking about making an end-of-year contribution for an additional tax deduction this year. Please note the following guidelines:

- Contributions must be received by the charity by the last day of the tax year (December 31st).
- Checks sent by mail must be postmarked by Dec. 31st in order to be deemed a contribution in the current year.
- Credit card payments (or payments through Faith Direct online giving) made on or before December 31st will be credited as deductible in the current year.

Remember ...

- our offices are closed Dec 23rd – Jan 2nd and that the postal service will likely have delays
- contributions received in the offertory through the weekend of Dec 25 & 26 will be included in current year contributions
- contributions may be placed in the black lockbox in the church or in the Parish office mail slot in the brick wall by the church entrance.
