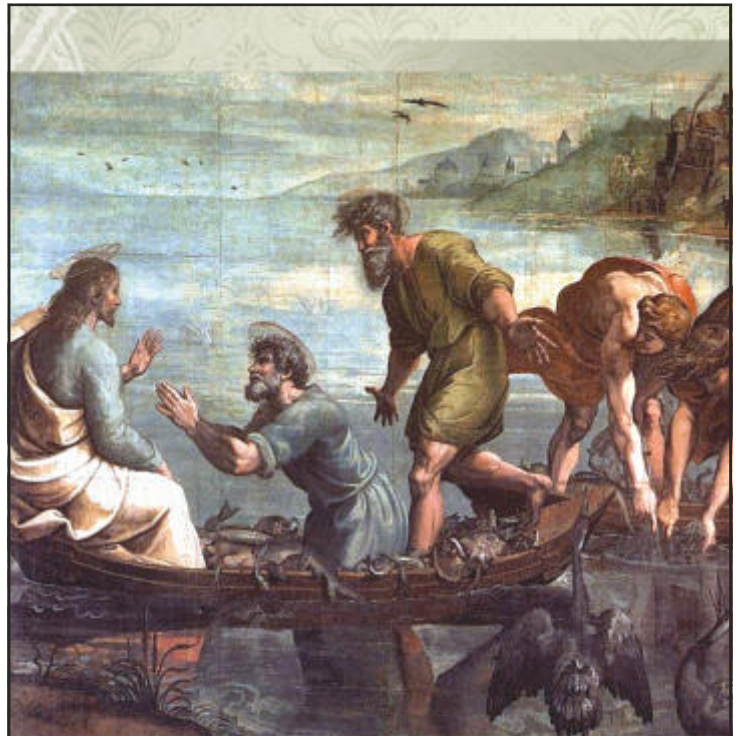
CONFESSIONS – Saturday following the 8:00 a.m. mass and thirty minutes before each Mass.

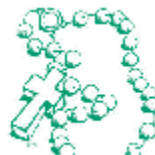

How the Lord prepares his servant...and us?

In the 3 readings of this 5th Sunday, It is obvious how the Lord forms and prepares his servants: - **1st stage: The manifestation of His Glory:** *Isaiah* "saw the Lord's Glory and heard the Seraphim crying: "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord"; *Paul* acknowledges also that "Christ appeared to me" on the way to Damascus; and *Peter* will touch Christ's Glory through the great catch of fish. We cannot be God's servant without a personal encounter with Him, an EXPERIENCE of His Glory- **2nd stage: The Self-knowledge of one's misery:** In contact with the Lord's holiness *Isaiah* says "Woe is me, for I am a man of unclean lips"; *Paul* also acknowledges his own sin: "for I am not fit to be called an apostle because I have persecuted the Church of God; and *Peter* fell at Jesus' knees crying: "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man". We cannot be God's servant without a true knowledge of who we are in reality: poor sinners - **3rd Stage: The cleansing:** When the Lord reveals our sinfulness, it is always to clean us. *Isaiah* is told: "Your wickedness is removed, your sin purged"; *Paul* will make the experience of God's grace, which is his Mercy: "But the grace of God I am what I am"; and *Peter* will be healed of his sin by his threefold confession of his love for Jesus. We cannot be God's servant without a personal experience of God's Mercy. -**4th stage: Ready to be sent:** *Isaiah* is now ready: "Here I am Lord, send me"; *Paul* is also now ready "to toil for Christ" by preaching the Gospel, "not I, but the grace of God that is with me"; and *Peter* is made "a fisher of men" by Jesus. Let us ask the Lord the grace to pass regularly through those 4 stages to become true missionary disciples.

¿Cómo prepara el Señor a su siervo... y a nosotros?

En las lecturas de este quinto domingo, es obvio como el Señor forma y prepara a sus siervos: - (1) **La primera etapa: la manifestación de Su gloria:** Isaías: "vió la gloria de Dios y escuchó a los ángeles serafines cantando: "Santo, santo, santo es el Señor"; Pablo reconoce también que "Cristo se me apareció" en el camino a Damasco y Pedro tocará la gloria de Cristo al recoger una pesca milagrosa. No podemos ser siervos de Dios sin haber tenido un encuentro personal con El, una EXPERIENCIA de Su gloria. (2) **La segunda etapa: conocer la miseria propia:** entrando en contacto con la santidad del Señor Isaías dice: "¡Ay de mí, estoy perdido! Soy un hombre de labios impuros"; Pablo también se enfrenta a su propio pecado: "soy el más pequeño entre los apóstoles y que no merezco el nombre de apóstol, porque perseguí a la Iglesia de Dios"; y Pedro cayó a los pies de Jesús diciendo: "Señor, apártate de mí, que soy un pecador." (3) **La tercera etapa: la purificación:** cuando el Señor nos revela nuestra pecaminosidad, es siempre para limpiarnos. A Isaías se le dijo: "tu culpa desaparece, se perdona tu pecado"; Pablo también vivió la gracia de Dios, lo cual es su misericordia: "La gracia divina ha hecho de mí lo que soy"; y Pedro será sanado des su pecado en su confesión triple del amor por Jesús. No podemos ser siervos del Señor sin una experiencia personal de la misericordia de Dios. (4) **La cuarta etapa: listo para ser enviado:** Isaías ahora está listo: "Aquí estoy Señor, envíame"; Pablo también está listo "a trabajar para Cristo" predicando el Evangelio, "no yo, sino la gracia de Dios que actúa en mí"; y Jesús hace de Pedro "pescador de hombres". Pidámosle al Señor la gracia de pasar regularmente por estas 4 etapas para convertírnos en verdaderos discípulos misioneros.

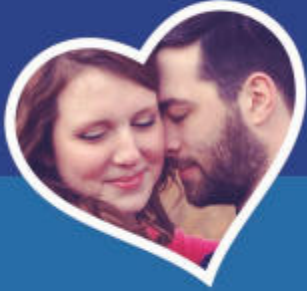
