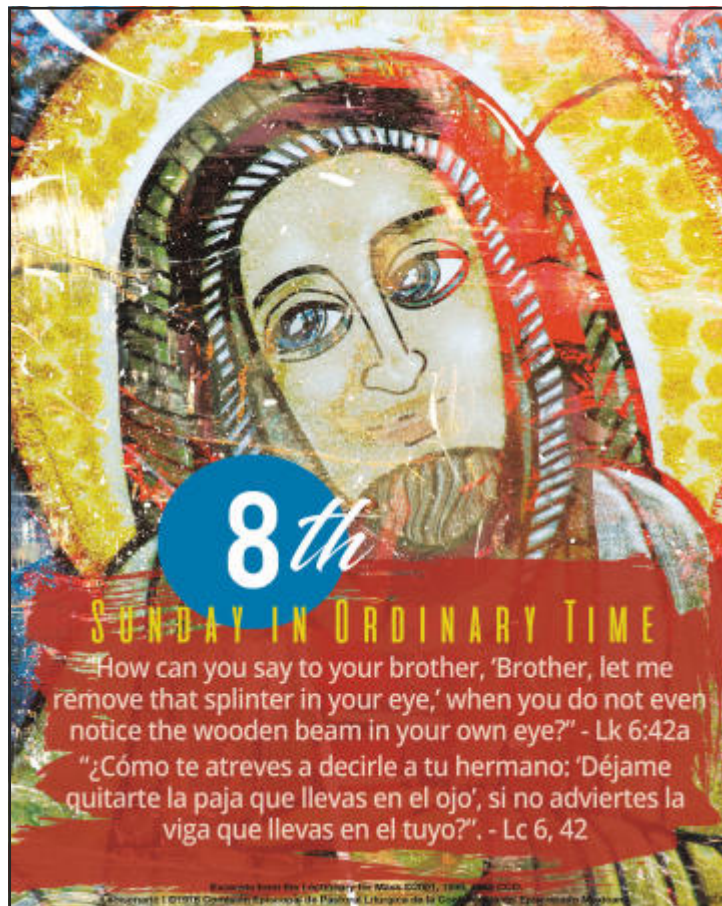
CONFESSIONS – Saturday following the 8:00 a.m. Mass and thirty minutes before each Mass on Sunday.

Who am I to judge this person?

This Sunday the book of Sirach (1st reading) and Jesus (Gospel) teach us *common sense*: We come to know a person through his speech (1st R) and every tree (that is: every person) is known by its own fruits (his actions). The mystery of a person (that is what we are!) is revealed through his/her actions. We only have the visible works to enter the "mystery" of a human being. This can of course be applied to God himself: His mystery is made known to us through his actions in the history of salvation. It is obvious for us to come to the conclusion that God is good (just open your eyes on the beauty of creation!), but when it comes to human beings, it becomes more problematic because we are *mixed creatures*: In each of us, there is a mingling of good wheat and evil weed. Thus, how easy is it for us "to notice the splinter in my brother's eye, but not perceive the wooden beam in my own"! How easy for me to judge others forgetting my own misery. This is the work of the devil: he loves showing us our brother's faults so that I can accuse him, maintaining myself in my own illusion: "I'm quite a nice person compared with others". Becoming a bit more Christian (it's a daily task) implies, with the help of God's grace I come to know myself more and more (the abyss of my misery), becoming much more merciful to others. Pope Francis is a man who has done this difficult journey. That is why when asked on the papal plane a question about gay people he was able to answer: "Who I am to judge this person?".

Quien soy yo para juzgar a esta persona?

Este domingo el libro de Eclesiástico (1era lectura) y Jesus (Evangelio) nos enseñan sentido común: Llegamos a conocer a una persona mediante sus palabras (1era lectura) y cada árbol (o sea: cada persona) se conoce por sus frutos (sus acciones). El misterio de una persona (¡eso somos realmente!) es revelado a través de sus acciones. Solamente tenemos las acciones visibles para entrar en el "misterio" de un ser humano. Esto, claro, se puede aplicar a Dios mismo: Su misterio se nos da a conocer mediante sus acciones en la historia de la salvación. Es obvio que concluimos que Dios es bueno (¡es suficiente el abrir los ojos a la belleza de la naturaleza!), pero cuando se refiere a los seres humanos, es más problemático porque somos *criaturas mixtas*: en cada uno de nosotros hay una mezcla de buen trigo y hierba mala. ¡Que fácil es para nosotros "fijarnos en la pajita que tiene nuestro hermano en el ojo, pero no darnos cuenta de la viga que tenemos en el nuestro!" Que fácil es para mí juzgar a otros y olvidar mi propia miseria. Esta es la obra del diablo: a él le gusta enseñarnos las faltas de nuestro hermano para acusarlo y así nos mantenemos en nuestra propia ilusión: "Yo soy una persona buena comparada con otros." El ser cada día más Cristiano (es una tarea diaria) implica, con la ayuda de la gracia de Dios, conocerme a mí mismo más y más (el abismo de mi miseria), esto nos hace mucho más misericordioso con otros. El Papa Francisco es un hombre que ha recorrido esta jornada. Por eso, durante un vuelo en el avión papal cuando se le hizo una pregunta acerca de los homosexuales él pudo responder: "¿Quién soy yo para juzgar?"

Lenten Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all of the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Regulaciones de Cuaresma

La abstinencia de carne es para ser observado por todos los Católicos de 14 años y mayores. Iniciando el Miércoles de Ceniza, y cada Viernes de Cuaresma terminando el Viernes Santo. **El ayuno** es observado el Miercoles de Ceniza y el Viernes, para todos los que tengan 18-59 años de edad. Los que sientan esta obligación pueden tener sólo una comida completa. Dos comidas más pequeñas se permiten si es necesario para mantener la fuerza de acuerdo a las necesidades de uno, pero comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas no está permitido.

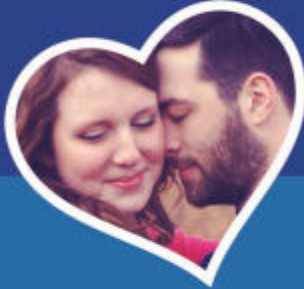
