## PRAY FOR LIFE

Bishop Golka has asked our diocese to pray during the next 6 months pending the Supreme Court's decision on whether a state may enact limits on abortion before a baby is capable of living outside the womb. Bishop Golka urgently asks all to pray that Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health be upheld, for the Supreme Court, and for us to reverence ALL human life. 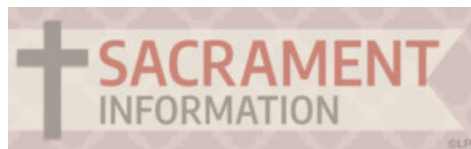

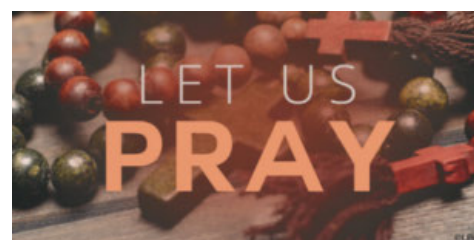

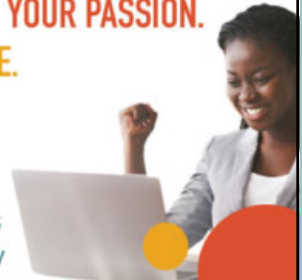
