

PRAY FOR LIFE

Bishop Golka has asked our diocese to pray during the next 6 months pending the Supreme Court's decision on whether a state may enact



limits on abortion before a baby is capable of living outside the womb. Bishop Golka urgently asks all to pray that Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health be upheld, for the Supreme Court, and for us to reverence ALL human life. He asks that we offer a work of mercy or act of charity each week in the service of human life, that we pray the First Saturday Rosary for conversion of all involved in abortion, and that we accept sufferings and hardship in reparation for the 63 million lives destroyed since 1973.


