This weekend I just wanted to give a quick heads-up to some of our annual Food Bank-related events and collections. First off is the ever-popular fruit fundraiser, which is made possible thanks to our partnership with Noland Orchards. They tell me that they should have specific details about their peaches and pears by the end of May. Hopefully, when we hear back from Noland Orchards, I'll be able to share with you all the costs and timeline for those delicious Western Slope fruits. A few parishioners have asked about cherries - unfortunately, due to some tree damage suffered back in 2020, Noland Orchards won't be able to offer cherries as part of our fundraising efforts. Maybe one day, but not this year.

Later in the summer, we hope to continue to offer school supplies to our client families with school-age children. This has been a very successful endeavor in past years so we hope to continue the program this year as well. There will definitely be a call out for school supplies as the summer progresses so watch this space!

Lastly, usually around mid-summer, we hold another Parish Food Drive. As I've mentioned, our Spring Food Drive was a great boost to our pantry stores so I won't be surprised if our summer drive is just as bolstering. Again, details will be in the bulletin and on the webpage as we get closer.

As always, I cannot articulate well enough how much the Food Bank ministry benefits from your unceasing support and prayers. Thank you for continuing to give to the ministry and allow us to fulfill our mission to feed the hungry in our community. God bless!

Gospel Meditation

Jesus tells his disciples, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you.” The peace that Jesus gives is far different than the kind that comes from the absence of war, conflict, or affliction. The peace that God offers is found alongside suffering and hardship, not necessarily in their absence. St. Teresa of Avila offers us a bit of wisdom regarding peace: “May today there be peace within. May you trust God that you are exactly where you are meant to be. May you not forget the infinite possibilities that are born of faith. May you use those gifts that you have received and pass on the love that has been given to you. May you be content knowing you are a child of God. Let this presence settle into your bones and allow your soul the freedom to sing, dance, praise, and love. It is there for each and every one of us.”

In order for us to experience the divine peace that Jesus offers, we have to allow God’s presence to settle into our bones! It is only when this happens that we can be truly taught by the Holy Spirit to discern the true path to peace and find ourselves with untroubled hearts. The world and our lives are so unpredictable and changeable. If we look for a source of lasting and real peace only there, our search will never be satisfied. Something will always unsettle and disturb us. The Jewish disciples could really relate to what Jesus was saying about peace (shalom). They already knew that it was more a matter of achieving wholeness and well-being than anything else.

Wholeness and wellbeing are precisely what is uncovered when we begin to really see and know the height, depth, and breadth of God’s presence and promise. The elegance of God’s Divine life flows through our blood and the marrow in our bones. It is that close and deep. As we breathe in and exhale God’s life, peace becomes what we know within and what is exhaled out. This remains in the midst of intense conflict, persecution, suffering, rejection, and even death. ©LPi

Highlighting our Saints

*St. Rita of Cascia
May 22*



St. Rita of Cascia (1381 – 1457) had the opportunity to live her life as a wife, mother, widow, and eventually, member of a religious community. Born in central Italy, St. Rita felt the calling to become a nun, but was pressured at a young age into marriage. During her 18-year marriage to a cruel man, she raised two sons. When her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons died, St. Rita decided to go back to her first love and attempted to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. Her status as a widow caused some complications to her entering, but she eventually succeeded in professing vows.

Throughout her lifetime, St. Rita of Cascia was known for her prayerfulness and charity. She also experienced stigmata on her forehead, meditated frequently on Christ’s passion, and cared for the nuns of her religious community and those in the lay community who came to her for counsel. © LPi

Nuestros Santos

Santa Rita de Casia
22 de mayo



Santa Rita de Casia (1381 - 1457) tuvo la oportunidad de vivir su vida como esposa, madre, viuda y, finalmente, miembro de una comunidad religiosa. Santa Rita, nacida en el centro de Italia, sintió el llamado a convertirse en monja, pero fue presionada a casarse a una edad temprana. Durante su matrimonio de 18 años con un hombre cruel, crió a dos hijos. Cuando su esposo murió en una pelea y sus hijos murieron, Santa Rita decidió volver con su primer amor e intentó unirse a las monjas agustinas en Casia. Su condición de viuda le ocasionó algunas complicaciones a su ingreso, pero finalmente logró profesar los votos.

A lo largo de su vida, Santa Rita de Casia fue conocida por su oración y caridad. También experimentó estigmas en la frente, meditó con frecuencia sobre la pasión de Cristo y cuidó de las monjas de su comunidad religiosa y de la comunidad laica que acudía a ella en busca de consejo.

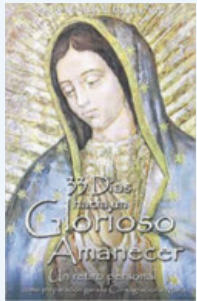


MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

“Jesús promete a los Apóstoles el don del Espíritu Santo, cuya tarea será enseñar y recordar sus palabras a la comunidad de discípulos. Enseñar y recordar: esto es lo que hace el Espíritu Santo en nuestros corazones” (Papa Francisco). Es muy cierto y se tiene la experiencia, de que, la persona que se abandona al Espíritu Santo, da muchos frutos de continua enseñanza y de obras buenas que el Espíritu de Dios hace en ella. Los santos y santas lo han experimentado en sus vidas, mostrando su fe con hechos. El amor de Dios nunca se cansa, si está presente, suceden cosas maravillosas.

“El que ama verdaderamente a Dios, observa sus mandamientos y Dios entra en su corazón y ahí permanece, porque el amor de Dios llena de tal manera su corazón, que al tiempo que le da tentación, no vuelve a su vida pasada” (San Gregorio Magno (540-640) Homilía 30). El reto, en este Sexto Domingo de Pascua, es que continuemos abriendo nuestro corazón y mente a la paz y al amor del Señor. Esa paz y su amor ayudarán a sanar las heridas sufridas por falta de amor, y quitará el miedo que se arraiga en la vida de la persona, a causa, muchas veces, de la falta de Dios en su vida. “Les dejo la paz, les doy mi paz, la paz que yo les doy no es como la que da el mundo. Que no haya en ustedes angustia ni miedo” (Juan 14:27). Oh, bien. “Si alguien me ama, guardará mis palabras” (Juan 14:23). 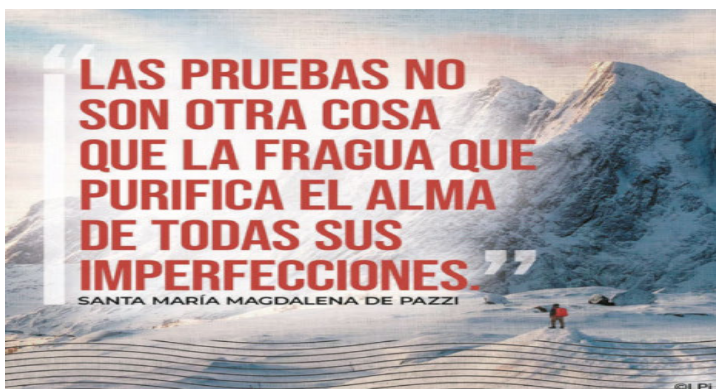

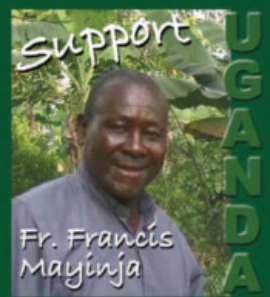

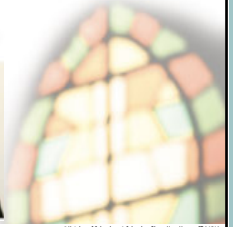
