



St. John the Baptist Food Bank News

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. – Philippians 4:19

There's a meme that circulated a while back on a Catholic Facebook group that I'm very fond of. It said: "God doesn't give us anything we can't handle, but He doesn't expect us to handle it alone." I remember feeling like this was a revelation. For me, it both meant that I could ask for help when I needed it - without shame - and I could be the hand that helps someone else carry their load. That's what the Food Bank ministry is to me - our clients are struggling beneath what they need to carry, and we are there to help them lift that weight, even just that small bit.

Which segues nicely into the Parish Holiday Food Drive happening this weekend! The Knights of Columbus and other volunteers will be on hand after all Masses to hand out donation bags for the Food Drive. Please consider taking a bag or at least the list of much needed food items with you on your next grocery trip. You can bring your donations back next week and drop them off with the Knights before each Mass. You are also welcome to bring your donations to the Parish or to the Food Bank during regular business hours. Our shelves are lighter than normal right now, and we hope this food drive will bolster our stock enough so we can provide generous boxes to our clients over the course of the holidays.

The list of needed food items have been posted in previous bulletins and is also posted on the Food Bank's website (just check under the Ministries tab). Our standard pantry items as well as 'traditional' holiday fare are all needed for this food drive. Egg cartons, diapers (sizes 4, 5, and 6), and special diet items are equally desired. Please give what you can - as I always say, even a small amount can be a great blessing to those in need.

Lastly, I am still making the call for volunteers to join our ministry. Our need for weekly delivery drivers is growing - as of the writing of this article, there are close to a dozen homebound clients on our "waiting list," hoping to be set up for food delivery since they are unable to come to the warehouse on their own. If you are able to help out with deliveries, please reach out to me at your convenience. If you don't think you can help with deliveries but you would like to help in the warehouse, we are still looking for a couple volunteers to help us out Tuesdays in the early to mid-afternoon and Wednesdays from the mid to late afternoon. Again, check in with me if you're interested.
