



This weekend we celebrate Christmas Day on Saturday and the Feast of the Holy Family on Sunday. Our Christmas readings bring to closure that long expected waiting for the Messiah. Jesus comes into our world to bring light into darkness, to bring joy, glad tidings and

peace to all the world. God will change all things for the people of Israel. The angels proclaim the Good News to first the shepherds and then to all people. Jesus Christ, the Word make flesh has come to earth to save us all. He will overcome sin and death for all of us and unite us to himself for all eternity.

For the Feast of the Holy Family we focus on the reality that we are all God's children and a gift to each other. The Book of Samuel talks about Hannah, the barren wife of Elkanah, who is blessed with a child in her old age. She promises her son to God and is a role model for all mothers. Hannah was committed to God and persistent in her prayer. Samuel grows up in the temple, close to the Ark of God. His mother continues to care for him. Samuel was also mentored by Eli. Because of his closeness to God he responds to God's call as he grows up. He makes his own commitment: "Speak, for your servant is listening."

Our 2nd reading is from the first Letter of St. John. The word love is mentioned over 2% of the time in their readings. That's how important the reality of God's love is. We are children of God because of his love and his life. His grace reaches all people of every time and place. Unfortunately the world rejects the love God offers us all too often. Too many distractions happen in our lives that would take us away from what God wants. That's why Jesus comes into our lives and gives us the direction we need.

In Luke's Gospel, Mary, Joseph and Jesus travel to Jerusalem for the Feast of Passover. They begin to travel home, while Jesus stays at the Temple. He astounds the teachers by his questions and stays for three days. His parents are full of "anxiety". When his parents find him he response is "I must be in my Father's House or about my Father's business. His time is not now, so he returns home with his family. This events helps to shape our version of his whole life.

"Faith In Action Idea Of The Week"

Read one chapter of Proverbs each day in January

The Holy Family experienced many of the same joys and trials that all parents and children experience today. And, so, we can look to this Family for help in our own family lives and see in them a model of stewardship in family life.

The Gospel passage from Luke starts by telling us something about Jesus' parents: "Each year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of the Passover, and when he was 12 years old, they went up according to festival custom." This Family took seriously the stewardship of their time. The "Holy Couple" carefully observed the traditions and practice of their Jewish faith and brought up their Son to do the same. They worshiped as a family, and with their faith community. And they did so faithfully.

We can take their example to heart by making Sunday Mass attendance a priority for our families, by making prayer with our family a priority every day, by making sure that we regularly celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and by observing in our family life the feasts and fasts appropriate to the liturgical calendar. When we, as families, prioritize our Time with God and worship of Him we will be imitating the Holy Family.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, let us reclaim the beauty and importance of family life. Let's commit to steward our families well in 2022, making time spent with God and practicing our faith the most important appointments on our family calendars.
