

This weekend we celebrate three important days: The Feast of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, which is also the beginning of a New Year 2022, and the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. The New Year coincides with new life brought forth from Mary the Mother of

Jesus Christ. The Epiphany literally means to show faith to make "manifest". The star lights the way for all of us to see the Light of Life Jesus Christ the Son of God. Historically these are very significant events in all of our lives. Just making it to the new year is an amazing event.

Mary, as the Mother of God participates in a singularly amazing way in her role in the mystery of salvation. In the Old Testament, the blessing given to Aaron was to be passed on to the people of Israel. The words, "The Lord let his face shine upon you and be gracious to you!" God truly dwells in our lives and is always with us. This is in contrast to the people of Israel who abandoned God and thought that he forgot about them. God has literally became part of our human life. The grace of the Holy Spirit given to Mary provides us with the reality of God within us. Mary gives birth to Jesus, fully human and fully God. 
"Faith In Action Idea Of The Week"

Look back one year from today and be amazed at how much deeper your Faith has become.

Today is the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. For centuries we as Catholics celebrated this Feast on Jan. 6, but the decision was made a number of years ago (at least in the United States) to celebrate the Epiphany on the Sunday which falls between Jan. 2nd and Jan. 8th.

"Epiphany" means "manifestation." It is on this day that Jesus Christ, the Messiah, is revealed as the light of all nations. Officially Christmas is not over. In fact, the recommendation of the Church is that on this day those who display a crèche, a nativity or manger scene, should replace the shepherd and sheep with the Magi and their likely animals on which they traveled as well as their gifts. However, that is all secondary to the real meaning of this day.

At Christmas the Messiah Jesus was revealed to the shepherds, who were Jewish. But on this day the Lord is revealed to all nations and to the Gentiles (represented by the Magi). We are all familiar with the star the Magi followed, but we need to understand all that is happening and what it means. This all represents the Light of Christ, a Light which today we honor and commemorate. We are called to be the Light of Christ right now to those around us and those with whom we come in contact. That way we can be the disciples Christ wants us to be. The poet William Cullen Bryant captures the significance of the star the Magi followed very well when he wrote, "O Father, may that Holy Star, Grow every year more bright, And send its glorious beams afar, To fill the world with light."
