Children's Faith Formation (CFF) News

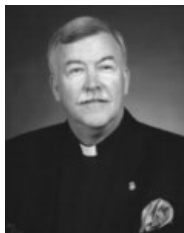
Happy New Year! Don't forget, classes will resume on Sunday, January 9th!

This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. In our first reading Isaiah, the prophet, tells the people of the comfort and joy that is to be expected from God. Imagine the excitement of the people of Israel. Their pain, suffering and misery will be over. This certainly is a boost in the morale of all the people. God has not abandoned his covenant with the people of Israel: "Comfort, give comfort to my people". Jesus has come into our lives to bring us God's Word. Jesus is the Word. Our call is to listen to the Word and respond by putting it into action in our lives. Living what we believe.

In St. Paul's letter to Titus he reaffirms that Jesus came to save all of us. “Faith In Action Idea Of The Week”


Attend the Knights of Columbus Breakfast and meet someone new.

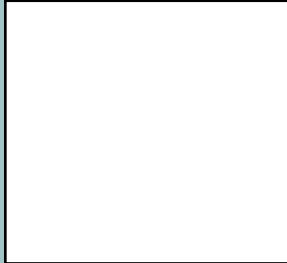
