

Happy New Year! Don't forget, classes will resume on Sunday, January 9<sup>th</sup>!


If you have a student who is preparing for First Communion, don't forget to keep signing them in when you attend Mass!!

This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. In our first reading Isaiah, the prophet, tells the people of the comfort and joy that is to be expected from God. Imagine the excitement of the people of Israel. Their pain, suffering and misery will be over. This

certainly is a boost in the morale of all the people. God has not abandoned his covenant with the people of Israel: "Comfort, give comfort to my people". 
#### "Faith In Action Idea Of The Week"
