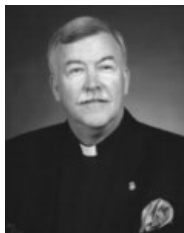

Children's Faith Formation (CFF) News

No Children's Faith Formation classes this weekend because of the Martin Luther King holiday! Classes resume on Sunday, January 23rd.

If you have a student who is preparing for First Communion, don't forget to keep signing them in when you attend Mass!!

Our next **Parent Faith Formation** Class will be this Sunday, February 6th and will run from 9:00-10:15am in the school cafeteria. The topic will be "Homosexuality". Jim Specht will be leading the discussion! This year, we will discuss and develop a better understanding of hot topic issues within the Catholic Faith and how to discuss them with others. The discussions will be based mostly on the "What to Say and How to Say It" books series by Brandon Vogt. These classes are free and all Saint Paul Parishioners are welcome to attend. We will also have free copies of the books to hand out!



This weekend we return to Ordinary Time. It is the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. There are different characteristics of all of our Church Liturgical Seasons. As of last Sunday, the Baptism of Jesus, our Christmas Season ended.

So, we now begin Ordinary Time as of January 10th. There are 33 or 34 weeks that the Church highlights certain aspects of the mystery of the life of Jesus. Christ and this mystery is most especially given to us on Sundays as we participate at Mass. This time is called Ordinary Time. Certainly there is never anything ordinary in celebrating Mass and our faith in Jesus. Throughout the other seasons of the year, we celebrate specific events always in preparation for the ultimate coming of Christ in our lives.

In our first reading from Isaiah, we hear a message of hope. The Jews have been in exile and could use some hope. Isaiah writes of vindication, restoration and new found freedom, "liberty to captives and a year of the Lord's favor". God will provide for his people. Truly God does provide for us, but not without some work on our part. That work involves knowing, loving and serving God in our daily interactions with each other. Sometimes our reading, like today's from St. Paul don't always seem to fit in with the Gospel or first reading. We need to understand that our lectionary is set up in this way, so that we might be exposed to as much Sacred Scripture over the three year cycle. Corinth is a busy and successful trade center with a diverse population. Some thought of themselves as better than others. Paul points out that there are many gifts, all given by the same God as he wills, for the good of all people.

Today's Gospel describes Jesus' first public miracle at the wedding at Caria in Galilee. A wedding is a big event. Imagine the humiliation of these families when they run out of wine. Jesus helps them save face and restores their dignity. The glory of God is revealed in this miracle of Jesus. God's people will enjoy a celebration "that known no bounds". God will provide an everlasting celebration for those who are faithful.
