

Children's Faith Formation (CFF) News

Classes resume this weekend!!!! See you all there!

If you have a student who is preparing for First Communion, don't forget to keep signing them in when you attend Mass!!

Our next **Parent Faith Formation** Class will be this Sunday, February 6th and will run from 9:00-10:15am in the school cafeteria. The topic will be "Homosexuality". Jim Specht will be leading the discussion! This year, we will discuss and develop a better understanding of hot topic issues within the Catholic Faith and how to discuss them with others. The discussions will be based mostly on the "What to Say and How to Say It" books series by Brandon Vogt. These classes are free and all Saint Paul Parishioners are welcome to attend. We will also have free copies of the books to hand out!



This weekend we celebrate the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. From the Book of Nehemiah we hear about Ezra, the priest and scribe. Both of these men are part of the Babylonian exile. They are being permitted to return to Jerusalem with some of the people of Israel. The city of Jerusalem has been destroyed, and Nehemiah wants to rebuild on behalf of the king. Ezra, just like Moses, sets up a prominent place and reads the Law to the people, explaining it as he reads. Many people had forgotten or abandoned the Law, so this was a good opportunity for instructions. We do the same thing in Church every week. Someone reads the Scriptures and the priest or deacons explain them. All done in a prominent place in the Church to show the importance of the Word, the Law from God. The people were instructed to rejoice and feast because of what God has done and will do for them and us. So rejoice at God's mercy and grace given to us in abundance when we come to Church.

In our second reading from St. Paul to the Corinthians, we hear a continuation of last weekends reading. The focus is on spiritual gifts given to us by the grace of the Holy Spirit. Using the Body as an example of how all it's parts work together, we as a Christian community are urged to work in unity to form this one Body of Christ. Every member of the Body is called by God to fulfill their potential.

Luke is the only Gospel written that explains why and whom he is writing about. He wants to give us an "orderly sequence" and "accurately" write it down for us. Today, Jesus returns to his home town of Nazareth and is preaching in the synagogue. He reads from the Scroll of the Prophet Isaiah: "The Spirit of the Lord is up me..." Then tells them: "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Jesus proclaims who He is and what He has come to do. Jesus has begun the ministry He was called by God to do. As we listen to the words of Jesus may we take them to heart, put them into practice and believe.

In St. Paul’s letter to the Corinthians, it states “If they were all one part, where would the body be? But as it is there are many parts, yet one body” (1 COR 12:18-20).
