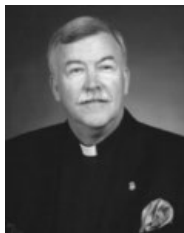
### **Children's Faith Formation (CFF) News**

Our next **Parent Faith Formation** Class will be Sunday, February 6<sup>th</sup> and will run from 9:00-10:15am in the school cafeteria. The topic will be "Homosexuality". Jim Specht will be leading the discussion! This year, we will discuss and develop a better understanding of hot topic issues within the Catholic Faith and how to discuss them with others. The discussions will be based mostly on the "What to Say and How to Say It" books series by Brandon Vogt. These classes are free and all Saint Paul Parishioners are welcome to attend. We will also have free copies of the books to hand out!



This weekend we celebrate the 4th Sunday in Ordinary time.

Jeremiah, the prophet in today's first reading is reassured by God of his care and concern for him. The prophets' tasks were sometimes difficult. They didn't always bring people good news.

Sometimes Jeremiah had to offer corrective action to the people. He was not always liked or treated well. Jeremiah not only spoke God's words to the people, he lived them in his daily life. God assured him in spite of some resistance from people he was doing a good job and that he would be taken care of. We too are called to speak and live God's words. If we do just like Jeremiah we will be taken care of. We belong to God. He will never abandon us.

In his Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul offers instructions on how a faith community should live and behave. Paul challenges all of us to live the ethical moral notions of love in our everyday life. Love isn't just sentimental and romantic. It's about hard work in real life. Our love of God is meant to be proclaimed by our words and actions. If we don't live what we say, what good are our words? We need to practice what we preach. Do what God has asked us. God's love sustains and nurtures us. It is meant to be lived and shared with everyone.

Luke's Gospel is a continuation of last week's Gospel message. Jesus is preaching to his own community. Some hear him and others reject him and his message. They don't like being told God is here for everyone, not just the people of Israel. His words don't fit their expectations. They are furious with Jesus and send him on his way. Jesus will continue his preaching in other towns and villages bringing the message of divine love and God's grace here for all. As we know Jesus will give his life as ransom for us because of his great love. We too are called to love and live it in our lives by our words and actions. May God's gift of love guide our daily lives. God bless!!

## STEWARDSHIP IT'S WHAT WE DO!

### “Faith In Action Idea Of The Week”

*“Do not be saddened this day, for rejoicing in the LORD is your strength!” From Nehemiah 8:10*

How do I know if the Time, Talent and Treasure I offer God in grateful return is “enough?” What is the measure?

St. Paul tells us in the Second Reading today — the “measure” is the love that we put into each of these aspects of our lives. “If I have all faith so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own and hand my body over so that I may boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.” God is not after a particular number. What He wants us to give over to Him is our very selves.

Real love is not a sentiment. Real love is manifested in living a virtuous life. We read later in St. Paul’s letter that real love takes strength: it is patient, kind, humble, other-centered, truth-seeking, and long-suffering. Love is the heroic giving of oneself even when it is uncomfortable; especially then. Love looks like Jesus. It lives like Jesus.


Sometimes, living like Jesus is difficult. We see this in the Gospel Reading today where we find Jesus in action, preaching in the synagogue in His hometown. He speaks truth to the people He loves, the ones He grew up with and shared His early days with. How do they respond? They are filled with fury and run Him out of town, intent on throwing Him from a cliff! Yet Jesus is undeterred. He passes right through them and presses forward with the mission His Father has entrusted to Him.

We are called to live with this same strength and determination, fueled by the power of love and by gratitude for all God has given us.


