

This weekend we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord.

St. Luke in the Acts of the Apostles, gives us a summary of the instructions Jesus gives to the Apostles to prepare them to spread his message of Good News. From the Resurrection of Jesus

to his Ascension is forty days. Forty days is a symbolic number for being prepared; for example, Noah and the Ark, Moses forty days on the mountain, Elijah wanders forty days in the desert and so does Jesus. The Ascension marks the end of the preparation of the Apostles basic training to be sent out to the whole world to be witnesses to Jesus. Jesus will give the Apostles the Holy Spirit. He formally commissions them to baptize people in his name and to preach and proclaim his word. The word of Jesus remains with us in the Spirit which he has given us. The Holy Spirit empowers us to give witness to Jesus and to the great hope we have been called to. Jesus ascends to heaven with shouts of joy and cries of gladness. He will be seated at the right hand of the Father as Lord God and Judge over all.

In our reading from Hebrews, we call to mend the reality of what Jesus did. He enters a sanctuary, not made by human hands, but by God. He delivers himself once and for all as the eternal sacrifice for our sins. Jesus overcomes death for us because he is the only one who can, unlike the high priests of the time and place of Jesus, who day after day have to offer sacrifices. Jesus takes care of it forever by his death and resurrection.

Today, we hear in the conclusion of Luke's Gospel the summary of the mission that has to be preached: Jesus had to suffer, He rose from the dead and we preach forgiveness and repentance in His name.

After his Ascension, Jesus sends his Apostles back to Jerusalem to wait for the promised Holy Spirit that he promised to send to them. We too are in anticipation of the great Feast of Pentecost, which we will celebrate next weekend. God Bless!! ~ Msgr. Bob
