



This weekend we celebrate the 19th Sunday in Ordinary time.

Today's readings from Wisdom and the Letters to the Hebrews introduce us to the early days of the people of Israel. God has chosen the people of Israel to be his own people. He establishes this bond in an everlasting covenant relationship, "I will

be your God, and you will be my people." This early relationship is built entirely on faith. Faith that God would keep his word and that the people would honor and worship this one God. God is preparing these people for the coming of Jesus.

Our second reading tells us about the faith of Abraham and Sarah. They trusted and believed in God's word. They were given a son along with the promise of establishing these people as a great nation, more numerous than the stars or the sands on the sea shore. Their journey, their lands and everything is based on their faith in God's word. This faith was confirmed over time in various ways. For Abraham and Sarah, the birth of a son and their ultimate destination to the Promised Land. Of course there were many struggles along the way. When people lost faith and trust, they suffered the consequences. When they had faith and trust in God, they celebrated their rewards and goodness. So all of life is a journey of faith in preparation to meet our Lord.

In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus offers us two parables about being prepared and having faith. We are once again cautioned about the things of this world not overwhelming us and leading us away from our path to heaven. We are asked to be ready in anticipation when the master of the house might return. So we must be vigilant and ready to meet the Lord whenever he comes. 


