
Baptismal Preparation:



This weekend we celebrate the sixth Sunday of Easter. Today's readings focus on Jesus as the Messiah who came to redeem us by offering his life.

Our reading from Acts of the Apostles continues to highlight the activities of the Apostles. Today, Peter gives credit

to Jesus for the things he is capable of doing he says, "I myself am also a human being". He speaks to both Jews and Gentiles alike, proclaiming the message of Jesus meant to offer all of us salvation. The Holy Spirit comes down on the Gentiles and Peter baptizes them, and the Church continues to grow everywhere.

Our reading from John reminds us that God is love and the more we show love the greater our potential is. God loves us so much he sent his Son, Jesus as expiation for our sins. The love of Jesus will sustain and nurture us always, but we have to allow our actions to be motivated by God's love in order to be effective.

The theme of God's love spills over to our Gospel of John. We are united with God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit through this intimate loving relationship. God's love is so great that Jesus laid down his life for us. No greater love is this, than to give their life for someone else. God has chosen us and commands us to love one another as he has loved us. So remember to tell the ones you love how much you care for them and don't be afraid to say "I LOVE YOU"!

The decree of the Lord is trustworthy, giving wisdom to the simple - Psalm 19:8

Our readings today call us to love as Christ loves.

In our Gospel, Jesus says, "Love one another as I have loved you." The ways Jesus has loved us and continues to love us are endless.

We are called to imitate this love. And He tells us the greatest way to do this when He said, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

It is difficult to live that out in our humanity. Yet, it is made much easier when we faithfully love Christ. The fact of the matter is, as our love for Christ increases, so too does our capacity to love others.

There are countless moments when we can do just that — for instance, waking up Saturday morning to attend daily Mass instead of sleeping in, or talking to God in the car on the way to work instead of listening to music. These are simple ways to express our love for the Lord by laying down our lives for Him.

The more we find ways to love the Lord, the more we will find it easier to put aside our selfishness and serve others.
