

From Our Pastor**PRAYER IN TIME OF SUFFERING**

God, You are holy and just and do all things well. You are Love and faithful to all who trust in You. Our history is full of Your love for us. You have blessed us with countless gifts for which we have not been grateful. You have helped us and supported us even though we were not thinking of You. The sufferings that we are experiencing now are the consequences of our actions. Even if we are innocent in one particular case, we have many other sins which You alone know. We have turned away from You. We have not listened to Your voice. We have stubbornly done our own will and looked for happiness outside of You and Your will. You have sent us prophets, but we have not listened. You have been gentle and sent us warnings, but we have not paid attention. We are guilty and our sins are in our hands. We have not sought Your will. We have not lived as you have called us to live. We are suffering because of our pride and others are suffering because of our pride. We have no one to blame but ourselves.



We need to be humbled. You are right to bring us to our knees. We see that we cannot give ourselves happiness. Our plans have come crashing down because You were not the foundation. We do not want to continue living without You, as it has never worked out for us. We see that our spiritual enemies are stronger than us. We know that You are on our side. We ask for justice against the spirits of evil. They have deceived us and lied to us. We have listened to them and cooperated with them because we have turned away from You. Come to our aid and cast them away from us. Open our eyes so that we can see the truth of Your love and Your presence. Help us to see the traps into which we have fallen and pull us out because we cannot get out on our own strength. We humbly accept the consequences of our sins.

In this Season of Lent, we recognize our faults. We do not defend ourselves or make excuses or blame others. Seeing our weaknesses and mistakes, we also forgive those who have sinned against us. We have mercy on those who have harmed us so that we can receive Your mercy. We put our lives in Your hands. We abandon ourselves completely to You. We give You permission to do with us as You will. If You see that this suffering is what is best for us, we accept. We unite our suffering with those of Jesus' and ask that You use them as you see best. Take good out of bad. We hide ourselves in the wounds of Christ and wait for Your merciful help.

We know that you are merciful and forgiving. Do not treat us as our sins deserve. Forgive us for the wrong that we have done. We desire to turn back to you. Bring us back to you; let us see Your face. Remember that Jesus has died for us; He gave His blood for us while we were still sinners. For the sake of His passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. We believe that in Jesus you are reconciling the world to Yourself. We trust that He will fulfill His mission to bring us back to You.

Thank you for listening and for taking our prayer into account. Thank you for helping us and acting on our behalf. We praise You and bless You. You are all good. We know that Your love is eternal and there is nothing greater than Your Mercy.

**What is the Chaplet of Divine Mercy?**

It is a Christian devotion based on the Christological apparitions of Jesus reported by Saint Faustina Kowalska (1905–1938), known as "the Apostle of Mercy." She was a Polish religious sister of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy and canonized as a Catholic saint in 2000. Faustina stated that she received the prayer through visions and conversations with Jesus, who made specific promises regarding the recitation of the prayers. In 1935, St. Faustina received a vision of an angel sent by God to chastise a certain city. She began to pray for mercy, but her prayers were powerless. Suddenly she saw the Holy Trinity and felt the power of Jesus' grace within her. At the same time she found herself pleading with God for mercy. As she continued saying this inspired prayer, the angel became helpless and could not carry out the deserved punishment. The next day, as she was entering the chapel, she again heard this interior voice, instructing her how to recite the prayer that our Lord later called "the Chaplet." This time, after "have mercy on us" were added the words "and on the whole world." From then on, she recited this form of prayer almost constantly, offering it especially for the dying. In subsequent revelations, the Lord made it clear that the Chaplet was not just for her, but for the whole world. He also attached extraordinary promises to its recitation.



