**From Our Pastor**

**THE GOOD NEWS**

God created the entire universe and saw that it was good. He created the stars and planets, the oceans and mountains, the plants and animals. Looking at nature, we can see the creativity of an artist who is powerful and brings beauty to all things.

What went wrong? The Christian story tells us that some of the angels were envious of God’s plan for mankind. The angels are superior to humanity in intelligence and abilities. Satan was envious that God destined such an inferior creature as man, to such great heights. Satan acts to thwart the plan of God by lies, division, and rebellion. Evil spirits are active in the world and we see the consequences: sickness, evil, suffering, injustice and death. The evil one is the prince of this world. He holds humanity in bondage through sin and the fear of death. We are not able to do the good that we want to do and we do the bad that we do not want to do. Our enemy is not flesh and blood. We are engaged in a spiritual battle and it is difficult to find another explanation for what we are experiencing. We are not able to free ourselves from the kingdom of darkness. Sin and death are powers that are superior to us and we are unable to rescue ourselves.


C.S. Lewis in *Mere Christianity* stated: “Enemy-occupied territory---that is what this world is. Christianity is the story of how the rightful king has landed, you might say landed in disguise, and is calling us to take part in a great campaign of sabotage.”

God entered into enemy territory taking on human flesh. The majority of the life of Jesus was one of hidden obscurity. During his three years of public ministry, He was constantly on the move. What was taking place on the cross? In addition to Jesus showing us the love of the Father and making reparation for our sins, some of the Church Fathers say that the humanity of Jesus was like bait to catch the devil. Jesus was abused, rejected, poor, and abandoned, and death swallowed Him up. He, then, entered into the place of the dead. The devil was unaware that he had accepted God Himself into His realm of darkness. Death was not able to hold the author of life. The light of the life of God was brighter than the darkness. Jesus was able to pull Adam and Eve from death. Life rose from death. Death was not able to hold onto the Love who is God. The kingdom of evil was undone.

With the resurrection, Jesus has established a Kingdom of God. God has fought for us and has been victorious. He is the new King who has ushered in a kingdom of justice, peace, love. We are no longer compelled to live enslaved to our enemy. The victory of Jesus is assured, and the devil’s time is limited. The evil one continues to act out of hatred and evil and we continue to experience the consequences, however, the eventual end is not in question: God has brought us salvation.

We can choose Jesus as our Lord and live under His kingship. We can also invite others to escape the kingdom of this world. Evangelization is letting others know that there is another possibility. We were created to share in the Divine life; it is the destiny God thought of for us. We can begin this new life now. Jesus shares His life with us in the Church and through the sacraments.

ST. PHILIP, THE APOSTLE
At the time of his call, Philip seemingly belonged to a group influenced by St. John the Baptist. He participated in the miracle of the loaves and fishes (John 6:5–9), accounting for his symbol in medieval art of loaves. With St. Andrew the Apostle, he brought word to Jesus that certain Greeks had asked to see him (John 12:21–22). In John 14:8–9, Philip asked Jesus to reveal the Father, receiving the answer, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you do not know me, Philip? He who has seen me has seen the Father.”
Nothing more is known about him from the New Testament. In later legends he was often confused with St. Philip the Evangelist (Philip the Deacon), one of the seven deacons of the early church (Acts 6:5). His apostolate was supposedly in the territory of Scythia, an ancient Eurasian area. He died of natural causes according to one tradition but, according to another, of crucifixion, accounting for his other medieval symbol of a tall cross.



Many people complained about how isolated, bored, and zoom-fatigued they had become with the pandemic. Henry David Thoreau decided to live by himself for the purpose of solitude. He lived in the woods of New England in the 19th Century and saw almost no one on a daily basis. But he was not bored, nor did he feel isolated. What did he do? What was his attitude? Maybe Covid has provided us with opportunities that we missed. A look at Thoreau's spiritual path might be a help to us in our daily life. Maybe the restrictions that have been placed upon us for the purpose of safety, can reveal missed opportunities for deepening our own spiritual growth. Thoreau made a conscious choice to let go many things that we think will fill us up. How and why did he do this? Let's look for our own inner Walden Pond!



Dios entró en territorio enemigo tomando carne humana. La mayor parte de la vida de Jesús fue una de oscuridad oculta. Durante sus tres años de ministerio público, estuvo en constante movimiento. ¿Qué estaba sucediendo en la cruz? Además de Jesús mostrándonos el amor del Padre y haciendo reparación por nuestros pecados, algunos Padres de la Iglesia dicen que la humanidad de Jesús fue como cebo para atrapar al diablo. Jesús fue abusado, rechazado, pobre y abandonado y la muerte se lo tragó y entró en el lugar de los muertos. El Diablo no sabía que aceptó a Dios mismo en Su reino de tinieblas.
