

From Our Pastor

Novena for Pentecost



On May 13, the universal Church celebrates the Ascension of the Lord. In the Archdiocese of Denver, this solemnity has been transferred to Sunday May 16. The following Sunday, May 23, we will conclude the Easter Season with the celebration of Pentecost. The days between Ascension and Pentecost are days of preparation for the coming of the Holy Spirit. During this time Mary and the apostles were in the upper room waiting for Jesus to fulfill His promise to send the *Paraclete*: a Greek word meaning a helper, advocate, comforter, counselor. They had their fears and doubts, but hoped in the words of Jesus.

The mission of Jesus was to bring the Holy Spirit to dwell among humanity. We need to receive a Spirit that is Divine as we cannot do good by ourselves. We are weak and fallen. At the same time, God is ever-present and always acting, doing good as we can see in the balance and harmony that exists in nature. The disharmony has come about because of the freedom of mankind. We, in our freedom, have rebelled and not cooperated with God. Jesus has revealed to us who God is: love, mercy, goodness. God has a good intention and desires us to be happy and fulfilled. We have looked for happiness outside of God and His will. It has not worked out well for us; we were deceived. Jesus was sent not to judge us but to save us. He reveals to us the truth about ourselves: God desires to espouse us and be in communion with us. Jesus, through His life, death, and resurrection has prepared a bride for himself, the Church, who has been washed clean through the Sacraments.

With the Ascension, Jesus is at the right hand of the Father to send the Holy Spirit to the Church. Mary at the Annunciation allowed God to dwell inside of her. She helps the Church to repeat her "Yes"; her Fiat: "Let it be done to me according to your word." With the sending of the Holy Spirit the apostles were filled with zeal to announce the good works that God was doing in their midst. They were able to cooperate with God and bring new life to those who listened and believed in their words. God acted through them in powerful ways; a Christian is a new creation who has received a Spirit that comes from heaven.

Let us join our prayers with those of Mary, crying out for the gift of the Holy Spirit. Let us give God permission to invade us so that He may fulfill His will in us. God desires the best for us and we can trust Him. Let us ask Him to work through us so that we may fulfill the mission for which He has created us.

The prayer that the Archbishop has asked us to pray is particularly appropriate for this time:
For the Archdiocese of Denver, that through the fatherly intercession of St. Joseph, patron of the universal church, the Holy Spirit will stir into flame our local church; boldly focused on mission and committed to announcing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray that God send His Spirit upon the world, the Church, our community, our family and each of us individually. Come Holy Spirit!

What is the difference between a “Saint” and a “Blessed”?

The process of proclaiming someone as a saint in the Catholic Church has evolved over the course of many centuries. In the beginning, those honored as saints were almost exclusively biblical figures or martyrs. However, after the legalization of Christianity in the fourth century, new holy women and men came to be honored as saints, and this was often done by popular acclaim or by the local bishop or abbot.

It was Pope Gregory IX (who was pope from 1227 to 1241) who officially proclaimed that only the pope had the authority to add someone to the official list (the “canon”) of saints. This is the meaning of the word “canonization.”

Today, the saint-making process includes several steps, including detailed studies of the person’s life and a recognition that they died as a martyr or lived a life of “heroic virtue.” Once someone is recognized as a martyr or if a miracle is attributed to their intercession, they will be beatified and honored as “Blessed.” This means that they can be celebrated by Catholics in a particular country or region or by the members of certain religious community. If another miracle occurs and is approved, then the “Blessed” is canonized and honored with the title “Saint,” meaning that they are now officially recognized as a universal model of holiness and an intercessor. ©LPi


ITS TIME.....MAY 23, PENTECOST SUNDAY

A volunteer can work a few hours or longer if they have the time. Volunteers normally are needed weekday mornings as we plant and harvest vegetables. No gardening skill or any special tools are required. All those interested may contact Bert or Gerry and we will place you on our email list. There is no obligation to volunteer at any specific time. Let us know if you have a desire to join us in distributing fresh produce to the people of Boulder County.



CARTA DE NUESTRO PASTOR

Novena de Pentecostés



El 13 de mayo la Iglesia universal celebra la Ascensión del Señor. En la Arquidiócesis de Denver, esta solemnidad se ha trasladado al domingo 16 de mayo. El domingo siguiente, 23 de mayo, concluiremos el tiempo de Pascua con la celebración de Pentecostés. Los días entre la Ascensión y Pentecostés son días de preparación para la venida del Espíritu Santo. Durante este tiempo, María y los apóstoles estaban en el aposento alto esperando que Jesús cumpliera Su promesa de enviar al Paráclito: una palabra griega que significa ayudante, abogado, consolador, consejero. Tenían sus miedos y dudas, pero esperaban en las palabras de Jesús.

La misión de Jesús era hacer que el Espíritu Santo habitara entre la humanidad. Necesitamos siempre presente y siempre actúa haciendo el bien, como podemos ver en el equilibrio y la armonía que existe en la naturaleza. La discordia se ha producido debido a la libertad de la humanidad. Nosotros, en nuestra libertad, nos hemos rebelado y no cooperamos con Dios. Jesús nos ha revelado quién es Dios: amor, misericordia, bondad. Dios tiene una buena intención y desea que seamos felices y realizados. Hemos buscado la felicidad fuera de Dios y Su voluntad.

No nos ha funcionado bien; fuimos engañados. Jesús fue enviado no para juzgarnos sino salvarnos. Nos revela la verdad sobre nosotros mismos: Dios desea desposarnos y estar en comunión con nosotros. Jesús, a través de su vida, muerte y resurrección, ha preparado una esposa para él, la Iglesia, que ha sido lavada mediante los sacramentos.

Con la Ascensión, Jesús está a la diestra del Padre para enviar el Espíritu Santo a la Iglesia. María en la Anunciación permitió que Dios habitara dentro de ella. Ayuda a la Iglesia a repetir su "Sí"; su "Fiat: hágase en mí según tu palabra". Con el envío del Espíritu Santo, los apóstoles se llenaron de celo por anunciar las buenas obras que Dios estaba haciendo en medio de ellos.
