

From Our Pastor

FATHERHOOD

When a child grows up without a father, that person is more likely to be filled with uncertainty and doubts about life. A father provides a foundation for the identity of his child. A person's image of God is influenced by one's father. If a father is absent, one will naturally consider God to be absent. If one's father punishes unjustly, one will believe God does so as well.


If I reject my father, I am rejecting my roots. A plant that has been cut off from its roots cannot thrive. If I reject my history, I am rejecting where I came from. By rejecting my father, I reject God because He gave me my father. If I reject my father, I am saying that God has done things wrong either because He does not care or is not powerful enough to do otherwise. I conclude that I have to take my life in my own hands and not trust in God. I have to give myself meaning and happiness.

What other option is there? No father is perfect, but God is perfect. Everything that you would like your father to be: loving, always present, desiring the best for you, loving you with all your weaknesses, providing and guiding you—that is who God the Father is. When your father was falling short in his mission, God was especially close to you and loving you. God allows events with eternity in mind. We all have to pass from our earthly father to God the Father. We never stop being sons and daughters of God. Behind all of the events in your life is the love of God. God has never abandoned you; He truly desires your happiness. We can trust Him with our lives and rest because He is a good Father.

The consequence of knowing God's love for me is that I am generous with others, I am full of gratitude and joy and am able to love others and give my life to others. If I do not know the love of God, all I can do is search for love from other people, from pleasure, money, or power. The only thing that will fill the desires of my heart is God, because only He is eternal. All other idols will fall short because there is only one Creator of heaven and earth. God created each one of us for a mission. Our unhappiness comes from not having a purpose in our lives. God has created you for a purpose. We have to trust Him in order to enter into His plan for our lives. The more we know Him, the more we trust Him. The evil that God allows are opportunities for us to mature, to grow in charity, humility, and holiness.

Let us ask God to open our eyes to see His immense love that has always been close to us. We are not orphans; we have a Father that created us because He loves us and desires that we spend eternity with Him.


***As I watched:***

THE INNER LIGHT

Rufus Jones was a Quaker who had a great deal of influence on the Quaker spirituality called the Inner Light. Why is it that we equate *power* with God? Why do we need God to be powerful? It might be that we are trying to make God into our image and likeness. We seem to like power and control. Jesus reveals not a God of power, but a God who liberates us by Love. The cross is anything but power. Resurrection is very powerful, but it does not come about through force, but rather through surrender to Love and Forgiveness. God's power is for transformation. The power of the State is not for transformation of the individual. Political systems, through fear, tend to disfigure power, and find enemies. So we focus here on transforming power.

The Knights of Columbus Council #1183 is selling Western Slope Elberta Peaches again this year!

HOW TO ORDER:

Before and after each mass on August 7th and 8th, and again on August 14th and 15th, Council #1183, which serves Sacred Heart of Jesus, Sacred Heart of Mary, Saint Thomas Aquinas, St. Martin

De Porres, and Saint Rita's mission church in Nederland will take orders for peaches before and after each Mass during those weekends.

HOW TO PICK UP:

This year, you can pick up your peaches at Saint Martin De Porres on August 28th and 29th. If you'd like, we can deliver them to you for a small additional fee.

COST:

Our 20lb box contains approximately 40 delicious peaches, which we sell for \$39. A half box will cost \$20. We accept cash, check, money orders and credit cards. We need to pay the orchard when they arrive, so we'll need payment on order.

You might even consider buying a box for a friend, the Homeless Shelter, or the Harvest of Hope pantry. All the profit we generate from the sale of these peaches goes to support our parishes, selected local community charities, and our efforts to purchase a new ultrasound machine for the Boulder Pregnancy Center. Although our peaches are not organic, they do not contain any preservatives.




