

From the Pastor

“The baptism of Jesus is on his part the acceptance and inauguration of his mission as God’s suffering Servant. He allows himself to be numbered among sinners; he is already ‘the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world’... At his baptism ‘the heavens were opened’— the heavens that Adam’s sin had closed – and the waters were sanctified by the descent of Jesus and the Spirit, a prelude to the new creation. ... The Christian must enter into this mystery of humble self-abasement and repentance, go down into the water with Jesus in order to rise with him, be reborn of water and the Spirit so as to become the Father’s beloved son in the Son and ‘walk in newness of life.’” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 536 and 537) As we recall the Baptism of Jesus may we be grateful for our Baptism that we are able to God our Father and be united with him. May we always stay clear away from sin that cuts this relationship.




