

## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### THE BATTLE OF PRAYER


Recently, I was perusing the Catechism of the Catholic Church, looking for another topic, when I came across the heading, "The Battle of Prayer". This title interested me very much as I had never really conceived of prayer as being like warfare! In studying this section of the Catechism, which is the 4th Pillar on Christian Prayer, I realized what is implied with this title. As the section begins it states, "Prayer is both a grace and a determined response on our part. It always presupposes effort. The great figures of prayer of the Old Covenant before Christ, as well as the Mother of God, the saints, and he himself, all teach is this: prayer is a battle." (C.C.C. #2725). The battle is very much with ourselves. We live as we pray and pray as we live. We must often work to overcome the bad habits of prayer, and inculcate the good habits of prayer. The Catechism points out several "objections" to prayer. The first is "erroneous notions of prayer". The Catechism defines this as viewing prayer as simple psychology, or just concentration to reach a mental void. Often we boil prayer down to its simple words and postures. Prayer is surely an attitude before God, leading to a deeper communion with the Father. This is where Jesus has always led us.

The second "objection" is the "mentality of this present world". Getting caught up in the reason and science of life, we forget the "mystery" of life. This is what prayer addresses and very often, the position from which we cry out in prayer. Prayer could naively be seen as simply an escape from the reality of our world. Prayer should elevate our thoughts and mind to God, the source and blessing of all that could actually blind us to Him. The blessings and goods of this life should lead our minds, words, prayers and works to Him.

Lastly, we often experience "failure in prayer". Expressing itself in dryness or sadness, when we cannot pray well, or find that we do not. This kind of an objection is truly centered around attachment. The attachment is too much to the world and its lures. The call here is for true virtue. We must battle to gain humility, trust, and perseverance. This is manifested best in our prayer. So, I guess in many ways there are difficulties in prayer which could be seen as a battle. But, truly fruitful prayer and a commitment to it are the best way to live our lives in God and for the glory of God.

### First Sunday of Advent

We Catholics are just weird. Here we are, twelve weeks into the school year (such as it is here in 2020), five months into the fiscal year, and eleven months into the calendar year, and yet, for us, the new year starts today. The First Sunday of Advent is where it all begins again. New hymnals. New colors (violets and pinks). New evangelist (St. Mark). New songs, in the minor keys of Advent longing. We live in chronological dissonance. And we love it.

From the earliest years of the Church, Christians marked time differently. Sunday—the day of the resurrection— became the primary day of worship, even though it was a work day in the Roman world. The early Christians felt that Christ should change the way they lived.


One of the bitterest indictments of our Catholic school system came from a friend of mine years ago. Observing that the kids in the high school graduating class all aspired to be movie stars and sports heroes, he said, “And aren’t we proud? Nobody will ever guess that our kids spent twelve years immersed in the gospel of Jesus.”

If we don’t hold to a consistent ethic of life, if we don’t have a special interest in serving those who are poor, if our agenda isn’t radically different from the agendas of either political party, then we are pretending that the Lord of time didn’t break into human history and make all things new, with Himself as the Alpha and Omega.

Yes, we weird Catholics start our year with Advent. We hold to a different time frame. It’s a “faith frame,” and everything in our lives should be set to that clock.


