

## Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

### THE SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

As a Catholic Church, we observe certain "rules", which we refer to as the "precepts" of the church. In addition to leading a sacramental life, studying the teachings of the church, doing penance, and supporting the works of the church spiritually and financially; the main precept is to keep the Day of the Lord's Resurrection. From this, we acknowledge our Mass obligation for Sundays and Holy Days. This is the way by which we best translate this precept. However, it expresses itself in a much deeper way.

This precept of Mass obligation really reflects the 3rd Commandment: Keep holy the Sabbath. Keeping holy the Sabbath does not simply mean attending Mass. It is a true honoring of the day of the Lord. For this reason, the Lord's day has traditionally been seen as a day of rest (forgoing unnecessary work), study (reading Scripture), and more fervent prayer. But, for most Catholics it shows itself most clearly in our attendance at the divine liturgy on the Sabbath.

At this pandemic time, we have been granted an indulgence to "supersede" the Sunday Mass obligation. This has been granted by the Pope, and passed along by individual bishops to their flocks. Right now, if we are able, we should endeavor to attend Mass on Sunday if possible in our area. If we are at risk: carrying co-morbidity, elderly,

or a high risk in any way, you are not required to attend Mass, and are actually encouraged not to. However we proceed, we should know that we are not "obliged" at this time. This applies to Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (for example, the upcoming Immaculate Conception feastday). Because of this, please do not feel the need to confess missing Mass. It is not necessary at this time. But, we are still a people who honor the Sabbath. I would encourage our parishioners to make every effort to keep holy the sabbath individually and in their families. It is especially important to our children to have this consistency in their teaching and our witness. We pray for the day when we can all be together, singing, praying and worshipping God as we were truly meant to do!

### LOOKING AHEAD TO CHRISTMAS

Christmas will offer many challenges during this pandemic time. We currently will schedule 7 Masses, with live-stream and car line Communion distribution at each. The space will be limited to 125 people arranged in 3 different venues. Thank you for your patience, and have a very holy, happy Advent!

4. Daily Mass. No need to sign up, just show up.



### Third Sunday of Advent

I get the best ideas from my friends. Two years ago my friend Julie shared with me how nice Thanksgiving was at their house because she laid out bags, water bottles, toothbrushes and toothpaste, and McDonald's gift certificates on the dessert table. After everyone had enjoyed the pumpkin pie, they carefully filled their bags with goodies to hand out to the people standing on the street corners.

What a great idea. I tried it with my family and they loved it, so we did it again last year and will do it for Christmas too. That little holiday discipline reminds me of Isaiah's "anointed one" who is sent to do all the hard things: heal the brokenhearted, release prisoners, and bring glad tidings to those who are poor.


It's the little things, really, that advance the kingdom. The person who knows no brokenhearted people is the person who is living a deeply isolated life. I'll bet each person reading this could name at least a dozen people struggling with a broken heart right this minute. And guess what? We're the ones God has anointed to heal them.

There are a number of ministries in the Church that address the spiritual needs of those in prison, and those ministries depend on us—God's anointed ones—to do the corporal work of mercy of visiting those in prison.

I have friends who easily engage those who stand on the sidewalk carrying a sign. They offer a warm smile, and always ask the person's name. They never give money, but they thoughtfully keep a small bag of helpful items for them. For some, a toothbrush can bring glad tidings better than a ten-dollar bill.




