

Fr. Chris' Catholic Cultural Corner

THE MARKAN "MESSIANIC" SECRET

This year, as we hear from the Gospel of Mark during most of the liturgical seasons, we are faced with a particular conundrum. It is something which Biblical scholars refer to as the "Markan" or "Messianic" Secret. It pertains to those times when Jesus will perform some amazing miracle, usually of healing. The crowds will be amazed or astonished. Then, Jesus will strictly instruct them not to tell anyone, but to keep it secret. We wonder why Jesus would not want his deeds to be widely known.

Scholars explain this in the following way. The key to the mystery is found only after Peter's confession of faith (Mark 8:27-30). Jesus' messianic identity is a deeper mystery than any of his followers yet fathom, and it must be unveiled gradually. The messiah of popular expectation was a political and military leader who would liberate Israel from Roman domination and usher in a new world of peace and prosperity. But Jesus had come to bring a much greater liberation--from the domination of sin, Satan, and death. Until the mystery of Jesus laying down his life on the cross was revealed, the risk was that sensational reports about his miracles would generate a false and distorted messianic enthusiasm.

It is somewhat akin to our mode of learning of Jesus and faith. It does not occur all at once, in our younger years. It comes through experience, through a knowledge of God's love,

through a recognition of God's hand in our lives, and his vocational call to each of us. We are actually quite fortunate that God reveals himself to us in this way. Lent is a perfect season to let God's love unfold in our lives, and to respond through our own Lenten works. God is constantly "showing himself" to his people, both as a group (in the church), and individually in our lives. We should always be open to this, even when it seems mysterious.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. KATHERINE DREXEL (March 3)

St. Katherine Drexel is one of our few American saints. St. Katherine was born into the wealthy Drexel family of Philadelphia in 1858. Throughout her very faith-filled life, she was always seeking to serve God in others. She founded the Missionary Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, with the charism of bringing education to those who were denied this basic right (especially African-American and native American children). She founded 49 institutions including Xavier University of New Orleans, the first Catholic university primarily for African-Americans. She died in 1955, at the age of 97, and was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II in 2000.



Below are the Income and Expense breakouts for the first 6 months of this Fiscal Year.

Second Sunday of Lent

Okay, let's take that Genesis reading and stare it down. It's awful. And it's not about what we thought at all. Whew.

Let's get this out of the way immediately. If any person attempted to "sacrifice" their son because God demanded it, we would quickly remove the child and get the parent psychiatric help. This is precisely what God is doing in the story of the sacrifice of Isaac. The entire story is meant for the ears of the neighbors, those terrifying Canaanites who killed their firstborn sons in huge numbers in order to prove to the gods of rain and harvest that they were seriously devoted to them.

See how the Canaanites behave? It shall never be this way with you, says the God of Abraham. It's God's way of removing the children from the scary parents.

When Abraham allowed Sarah to cast Hagar out into the wilderness (along with his firstborn son Ishmael, a thirteen-year-old) he did so because God assured him they would survive. Years later it was Isaac's turn to be endangered, as he himself had become thirteen (the threshold of adulthood). The same God who proved trustworthy earlier was demanding Abraham sacrifice his second son as a sign of devotion to him. Would the God who was faithful then be faithful now?

This isn't about a sociopathic god requiring the blood of children. It's about life's most important question: can God be trusted in our lives and in our deaths?

We've all stood at the grave. Like Ishmael and Isaac, we've stood at the threshold of death. Can God be trusted to bring life from death? That's the big question in this Lent's gospels. Take heart, and wait.

Can God be trusted with your life?

STEWARDSHIP OF YOUR TITHE

Every year, Spirit of Christ contributes financially to the second collections established by the Archdiocese. 2021 will not be the exception. Thanks to your amazing stewardship, Spirit of Christ was able to contribute \$1920 towards the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, and \$2000 towards the Black and Indian Missions.

Central and Eastern Europe The Lenten season is not only a time of penance and fasting, it is also an invitation to assist others who are in need. This year, thanks to your tithe, Spirit of Christ has contributed towards the Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. By participating, we have answered that invitation by helping our brothers and sisters in Central and Eastern Europe rebuild and strengthen the Church after 70 years of communist rule. Through your prayers and support, you help the Church provide ministries such as seminary education, support to families with special needs children, Catholic radio and TV programming, and young adult volunteer programs in 28 countries.

Black and Indian Missions Mandated by the III Plenary Council in 1884, the 125- year-old National Collection for Black and Indian people continues as the embodiment of the Church's concern for evangelizing the Black and Indian peoples of the United States. The funds that Spirit of Christ has provided, will be distributed as grants to dioceses throughout the United States, supporting and strengthening evangelization programs which otherwise would cease. The Collection was formerly known as The Black and Indian Home Mission Collection.

Fair Trade, After decades of corporate promises to end child labor in cocoa, there has been very little progress. Some of the largest chocolate companies, including Nestle, Hershey and Godiva, have the worst record. AND exposure to toxic pesticides has increased. Despite chocolate being a \$100 billion per year industry, cocoa farmers make less than \$1 per day. Fair Trade chocolate guarantees that no child labor was used in the growing and harvesting, and addresses the problems of cocoa farmer poverty, pesticide use and deforestation. You can order Fair Trade chocolate and many other items up until midnight on March 15th for pick up on March 27th. Special note to those parishioners making sack lunches for the homeless shelters, a couple of mini chocolates in the lunch can brighten someone's day and support Fair Trade farmers at the same time.


Sacrament of Confession: Sat. from 3:30- 4:45 PM, or by appointment


